Sessions

20. I can't attend the event. Will the sessions be recorded and accessible later?

Sessions will not be recorded. We will release any pre-recorded sessions in advance.

We will provide the opportunity for presenters to share their materials, however it may vary from presenter to presenter.

22. How long are sessions?

About 50 minutes.

23. If I want to attend a session that is occurring at the same time as another session, can I be emailed the recording of the one I missed?

Sessions will not be recorded. We will release any pre-recorded sessions in advance.

24. Will I have the option to choose what session to attend? Will I be able to attend a session that is not in my pathway?

Yes, you may attend any session on the schedule.

Speakers/Presenters

25. What will my room be equipped with?

Each room will be equipped with a screen, projector, speaker and MIFI *only*. Rooms that accommodate 63+ attendees will also have microphones. You will need to bring a laptop and an adaptor that can be used to connect to the projector. We will have a <u>few</u> laptops and adaptors on hand as back up. *Please bring your presentation on a flash drive in case you need to use one of our laptops. We also encourage you to bring a portable WIFI/hotspot in case there are internet issues.*



26. What kind of adaptor will I need for the projector?

The projectors have HDMI ports. If you have a Mac, you will most likely need a USB-C to HDMI adapter. If you have a PC, there's a chance you already have an HDMI port on your laptop. If not, USB-C to HDMI would be preferable. We will have a few laptops and adaptors on hand as back up. Please bring your presentation on a flash drive just in case you need to use one of our laptops.

27. How will the rooms be set up?

Classroom and theater style (with chairs and rectangle tables). Room sizes will vary and can accommodate 30 - 100 attendees. Unfortunately, we won't have an idea of who will be attending sessions until the day of the event.

28. Do I have to attend the entire day?

You are welcome to join us the entire day! If you can only attend your session or part of the day that is fine. Please keep in mind that parking will be limited after 8 a.m.

29. If I'm only presenting, do I still need to pay a registration fee?

If you plan to attend the entire day, you will need to pay the discounted speaker registration fee. If you are only attending your session, no fees are required.

Presenters - Up to 2 presenters per selected session will receive a \$50 discount on their registration fee.

Early Bird Presenter Registration fee due by June 30: \$175

Presenter Registration fee after June 30: \$225
