RFH Community,

Today marks the second week of having our students in class and the third week of having our faculty in the building. The plans that we put in place throughout the summer are contributing to the success of our reopening. We have had socially distant assemblies, athletic practices, virtual classes, hybrid classes and a Virtual Back to School Night. While each of these events was unlike anything we've seen before, they all reflect both our commitment to the health and safety of our students and staff, and our commitment to creating opportunities to learn. That is, we are committed to keeping our building open. Your involvement is essential to us achieving our goals.

- **Screening:** Students receive an email daily with their health screening questionnaire. We check that the questionnaire has been completed by scanning the student's ID at the appropriate entrance each day.
- Attendance: If your child is not feeling well, has traveled to a state on NJ's recommended quarantine list, or was with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, he or she must participate virtually. Call the attendance line to let us know that your child is participating virtually for the appropriate number of days. Our school nurse will follow up if there are questions. Families will be notified if we have a positive case at school.
- **Visitors**: During our hybrid phase, visitors to the building will only be admitted by appointment. Items for students may not be dropped off during the school day. All visitors are required to complete a health screening questionnaire upon arrival.
- Athletics and Extracurricular Activities: Athletic and extracurricular activities are taking place with a great number of modifications, both for our students and adults. Students who are quarantining for any reason must notify the coach directly. Fans are required to wear face coverings at our athletic events, which begin next week. Most clubs are holding their meetings virtually.
- Exercise caution: Continue to monitor and limit your child's activity in large groups and with people that they do not usually come in contact with. When your child is working or volunteering, or when participating in social or athletic events, it is recommended that he or she wear a face covering, wash their hands frequently, and limit these interactions when possible.

This is a time of transition, and transitions can be difficult.
