



Remote Learners FAQ's

Where do remote students find their assignments each day? Google classroom is a great place to start. Emails coming from Aeries will now have the campus, teacher, and subject in the subject line. This should help keep track of the emails.

How does a digital backpack work? - click the link for a little video!

Does every student have a digital backpack? - Yes, but it is up to the classroom teacher to utilize the backpack. The district has preloaded many of the backpacks with apps that the class might need. This includes online textbook and content specific websites.

Why do teachers assign zoom classes during other class periods than the one a student is enrolled in? Assigned/Mandatory Zoom sessions can only take place during the actual assigned period each day and during the 20 minute live time. However, some teachers are offering “digital” office hours for tutorials and extra assistance. These might be scheduled during other class times. These office hours are optional and teachers are encouraged to have additional office hours when they are made aware of scheduling issues.

What is the schedule for my Remote Student? Remote students will have a flexible schedule and will only be required to attend certain live sessions each week. These live sessions will only take place during the 20 minute live time for each period. Remote teachers will provide both recorded and live sessions to their students. In addition, teachers will be able to use a variety of other instructional resources (digital textbook, NearPod, DreamBox, etc)

What is?

Canvas & Google Classroom - These are learning management systems. This is where students are able to access assignments, lessons, and communicate with their teacher and classmates.

Google Meet & Zoom - These are video conferencing tools. These are used to host live meetings or virtual office hours. Some meetings will be mandatory while some will be used as needed, like tutorials.

Google Suite (Slides, Doc, Sheets, Drive, Forms) - A student's google drive hosts all of their documents and google items shared from their teacher.
