Attention all 11th and 12th grade students: On Saturday, May 6th, the senior class will be hosting the Red Carpet Gala prom at Edgewood Gardens from 7:00-10:30pm. Tickets will be on sale at all lunches during the week of May 1st-May 5th for the cost of \$30 each or \$50 per couple and no tickets will be sold at the door.

Guest passes for prom are now available in the office for those wishing to bring a student from another school. For those students who would like to bring a guest who is out of school, a background check form will need to be completed along with the guest pass. All guest passes are due to the main office by Wednesday, May 3rd, 2023 by 3:00pm.

Attention all Juniors: Tomorrow you will be taking the Science and Social Studies digital MSTEP test. Testing will start promptly at 7:45am in your testing rooms. You will need to bring your Chromebook charged and ready to go. If you will be using text to speech accommodations, please bring in Chromebook compatible headphones for testing. Cell Phones should remain at home, in lockers, or be powered off and left in your backpack which will be required to stay at the front or back of the classroom away from your testing area. If your cell phone makes any noise during testing, your test score will be invalidated and you will not have an opportunity to retake the test.

Attention Senior students: If you missed the ASVAB Career test, the make-up test will be tomorrow. Testing will start promptly at 7:45am in the cafeteria so please be on time and ready to test. Students please remember that these tests are not only required by the state but also by our district in order to be able to attend prom.
