The National Certificate: Vocational or NC (V) is an alternative option and equivalent to a Matric Certificate. Programmes are aimed at developing students in a certain specialisation with practical skills and knowledge that leads to a strong career pathway. Students completing their National Certificates have 4 open book Virtual Term assessments and one practical at a Hybrid centre towards the end of the year in order to complete the course for a NQF4 certificate. Homeschooled students can get support at their local learning centre or from a tutor or a mentor. After completion of your NQF Matric, you could enrol for any one of Hybrid's other accredited courses.

Hybrid Academy is registered with QCTO and offers NQF 2-5 National Certificate Occupational Programs to learners. CiPC registration number 2017/104349/07 and SACE number PRC0001119.

Nature conservation, hair&nails, IT, Baking, Counseling, Training, Space, Solar, Further study etc.) and still learn how to turn it into an income-generating opportunity, you may want to use terms that communicate personal empowerment, skills application, and self-reliance, rather than traditional "business" language - it's actually more of a New Venture - Career Starter National Certificate.

★1. How is the layout of the National Certificate courses?

The course is divided into:

- Knowledge Modules: Lesson-by-lesson course material with weekly quizzes.
- Practical Skills Modules: Hands-on guidance with weekly logbook submissions.
- Work Experience Portfolio: A weekly presentation showcasing work experience, graded by the facilitator.

★2. How do I get the required work experience for the Portfolio?

You can:

- Ensure you have a mentor
- Reach out to volunteer in the community.
- Contact any Hybrid Learning Centre.
- Reach out to the Hybrid School Mentors or Counselors for guidance.

★3. Where can I find details about the Electives and this course?

Check the **Electives section** on the learning portal. It includes step-by-step guidance on the course and the **Letter of Commitment** requirements.

★4. Why is the Letter of Commitment important?

The **Letter of Commitment** confirms your participation and dedication to the course. Without submitting it, you cannot begin the program.

★5. What are the Weekly Analytics, and why should I submit it?

The **Weekly Analytics** tracks your progress and is essential for evaluation. Submit it along with your weekly logbook to stay on track.

6. What are the attendance requirements?

- Attend a virtual support session once a week for feedback and guidance.
- Participate in live virtual sessions for term open book assessments, which are compulsory.
- Prepare for your 4 Hybrid <u>virtual</u> term assessments and 1 Hybrid practical assessment towards the end of the year and ensure you are available for attendance on the given dates.

★7. What are the virtual term assessments, and how do they work?

- There are 4 Virtual Openbook Term Assessments spread across the year.
- They are **open books**, conducted during live virtual sessions.
- A password will be provided during the session to login and submit your assessment.
- Students completing their National Certificates have 4 open book Virtual Term assessments and one
 practical at a Hybrid centre towards the end of the year in order to complete the course for a NQF4
 certificate.

★8. How do I stay organized throughout the course?

- Print the Weekly Dashboard Layout provided in the course materials.
- Attend Orientation sessions.
- Use dashboard and Analytics to track submission weeks for quizzes, logbooks, presentations, and assessments.

The course follows the **school's yearly calendar** and is completed in one academic year. 4 Terms and holidays in between.

7 weeks of support sessions, one week revision and 1 week virtual assessment.

★10. What happens after I complete the course?

You will receive a **Year-End Certification** upon successful completion of all modules, submissions, virtual assessments and final year end EISA open book assessment.

Year end assessment at a Hybrid Accredited Centre near you. This can only be done at one of our Hybrid Support Centres. If the centre where you are at is not a Hybrid Accredited Centre, then you will be directed to your nearest one.

- Utilize the resources provided in the **Electives section** to maximize your learning.
- Consistently communicate with your facilitator for guidance on your Portfolio and assessments.
- Prepare for your final year practical assessment at Hybrid Accredited Centres and ensure you are available for attendance on the given dates.
