Action Item

Discussion Items

1. Great College to Work For (GCTWF) Survey Results 2022

President Moore has charged UC to form a 3 person subcommittee to report results to the Cabinet+ on the February 14th meeting. Due to the many hours spent and outside resources on the last survey report, Auburn Isaak recommended increasing the number of people on the subcommittee. President Moore welcomed the idea of more people on the committee and advised the committee to make the final decision. The members who volunteered for this committee were: Robert Butler, Auburn Isaak, Bill Grigsby, Janie Carman, and Sam McCumber. In addition, Chris McLaughlin offered

his Administrative services if needed. This committee will report back to UC monthly. Also, the subcommittee would not have to develop action items from the survey but rather report on their findings. The action items will be developed collaboratively after that.

2. EOU Strategic Plan

With the departure of Holly Chason from EOU, the Co-Presidents have asked UC to hold on reviewing EOU Strategic Plan until they develop a charge. President Moore indicated due to the pandemic, some KPIs are not the correct measurements and will need to be addressed.
