Let's work together to make this experience accessible for all of us (heart emoji)

Here's a starter list of access considerations we've been thinking about, from the perspective of your needs as audience, and ours as the musicians – We'll have the chance to get into detail, after the initial interest form is filled out!

- Sound sensitivity
- Use of assistive listening devices, needs and/or requests surrounding working with this and live music
- Light sensitivity
- Scent sensitivity
- Airborne virus precautions needed
- other immune system related needs
- severe allergies
- mobility needs (like keeping pathways clear)
- request for image descriptions, sonic descriptions
- communication requests and needs, from font size for emails, request for voicemail rather than text, etc
- need interpreter (ASL, translator, any other type of interpretation)
- requests around length of visit, capacity needs
- request for check-ins (inspired by thinking about visiting a friend with mcf, checking in with how their symptoms are responding to things!)
- anything else you can think of !! This is an incomplete list, and know there are access needs that might not be listed yet – we would love to accommodate your needs in any way we can :)
