

Parking Guidelines

The Penn Manor High School Administration recognizes that students enjoy the privilege of driving to school and parking on school property. Students must be in good standing to be eligible for a parking pass, which includes academics, discipline, attendance and other requirements. Students who owe financial or discipline obligations will not be permitted to park on campus. Furthermore, as part of the district's drug screening policy, all students who wish to drive and park on school property will be required to submit to having their name placed in a pool for random drug screening.

PARKING PASSES ARE A PRIVILEGE

Driving Privileges and Parking Regulations

- Tags may be revoked from any student who has accumulated 6 or more unexcused tardies or absences.
- Failure to follow the code of conduct may result in the loss of parking privileges without a refund. ● Students may not park in a spot marked VISITOR or RESERVED for any reason. Students may only park in lots designated for student parking. Parking Deck, Athletic Lot and spaces along Model Avenue
- Students may not park on the lower level parking deck for any reason.
- Students may not transfer their parking tags, or share the tags with other students. ● Students who register for a parking tag are expected to drive regularly. We may have a waiting list for tags after the start of school. If you are unable to fulfill this requirement, you must notify the main office as soon as possible. Student tags may be revoked if they are only used periodically. ● If you purchase another car or drive another car to school other than the car you registered, you must notify the Main Office immediately.
- All drivers operating vehicles on school property are subject to Pennsylvania Motor Code and school regulations: 10 MPH speed limit, parking deck speed is 5 MPH, and obey all posted signs. ● Students shall refrain from sitting in/on vehicles and loitering in the parking areas before or after school. ● After arriving on school property, students may not leave unless they have permission from a high school administrator.
- Vehicles must remain in the parking area during the school day unless an exception is granted by the main office. Students may not access their vehicle during the school day without permission. ● All vehicles must have the appropriate school parking permit displayed on their mirror or on the back window. If a tag is not displayed, students may be subject to a parking ticket. Students parking in a lot not designated for student parking may receive a parking ticket from Millersville Boro Police Department. ● Parking passes will cost \$20.00 each semester.
- All vehicles should be locked. The school district assumes NO responsibility for valuables left in vehicles or damage to vehicles.
- School authorities have the right to search a student's vehicle without prior warning if there is a reason to believe the vehicle contains material which may pose a threat to the health, welfare and/or safety of

others.
