Awards

Note that each judge's placings will be awarded individually for the 2022 championship show.

1. Ribbons or other prizes awarded first through sixth place in standard classes.
2. Halter Championship classes will award rosettes to Grand and Reserve champion only, except for Supreme Champion, which shall award Supreme and Reserve Supreme only.
3. Performance Championship classes will be awarded rosettes Grand and Reserve Champion only, although horses will be placed through sixth in all performance championship classes.
4. There are several Judge's Choice awards that shall be presented after the completion of the show. These awards will not be announced prior to the show. Some of the awards shall be individually awarded by each judge and others shall require the judges to agree on the winner.

Notes

1. Class entries CLOSE for adding at 8am each day of the show. Entries can be scratched at any time.
2. Points will be tabulated according to the rules and regulations of the GVHS.
3. All forms MUST be signed by the owner/agent (must be 18 years of age). One owner per entry form. There will be a \$50 fee for checks returned.
4. There are no prior show qualifications required to attend this show. Any qualifications required for the Regional Championship classes will be qualified for at the show.

Show Definitions

Junior Horse – A horse 2 years old or under as of the January 1 birth year rule. (any horse born in 2020 or later)

Solid Color – Any horse who does not show any broken pattern. White shall not be extending past the ears or visible above the top of the legs when the horse is viewed from the side, front, or back.

Patterned Color – Any horse whose white extends past the ears, and/or on the visible portion of the body cavity when the horse is viewed from the side, front, or back. To include blagdon, tobiano, sabino, and spotted horses.

Green Horse – Horses in their first or second year of showing that discipline. The show season runs January 1-December 31. Horses may take time off between the years, but once they have graduated, may never return to Green status.

Stabling Information

The Double F Arena is a very nice facility with 280 stalls and 12 wash racks available. Stabling for ponies/cobs is available on the show grounds from Friday at 3:00 p.m. until Sunday at 7 p.m. All stabling is prepaid with entry fees. Those wishing to come earlier or stay later need to make arrangements with the show secretary. Shavings may be ordered at the rate of \$9/bag. Shavings will be set outside your stalls. First 2 bags included with stall fee. See entry form.

Other Information

Water is available on the grounds and there are 12 wash bays with hot water for ponies. There is a modern and clean bathroom facility with showers for those camping overnight. Camping is available on the grounds with an electrical hookup fee of \$55/weekend and additional \$25/night if staying longer. See entry form.

Minnesota Gypsy Horse Club Show Rules

1. All horses must be registered as purebred with the Gypsy Vanner Horse Society or another Gypsy Horse registry (GHRA, TGCA, GHA, etc.) Only those registered with the GVHS will be eligible for GVHS points.

2. Competition entries will include a Proof of Registration or Pending Registration.

3. Age of all horses is determined as of January 1 of the year they were born.

4. A Junior horse is defined as any Gypsy age 2 and under. Junior Horse classes are open to all horses aged 2 and under as of the year they were born (i.e. for 2022, all horse must have been born no earlier than 2020).

5. Registered Purebred Gypsy Vanner horses cannot compete in any driving or riding class until they are three years old.

6. Horse/rider combinations cannot cross enter WT and WTC.

7. All persons exhibiting as Amateurs must have an Amateur Declaration Form on file with their breed registry in order to compete in Amateur classes, and must include a copy of their 2022 Amateur card with their entries.

8. Classes may be combined or divided based on the size of the Competition and the discretion of the Competition management.

9. Mares and foals may accompany each other in the ring for all in hand classes. Foals must be haltered and under control.

10. Competition Management will resolve any questions or dispute that may arise from said eligibility of horses. This decision will be final.

11. All applicable classes are run in accordance with the current GHSA rulebook and will be judged and conducted in accordance therewith. For current rulebook, visit:

12. No fees paid to Minnesota Gypsy Horse Club for entries will be refunded for any reason unless a valid medical reason is submitted by a physician or veterinarian. Stall fees are not refundable. All disputes will be adjudicated by the show rules committee.
13. Closing date for pre-entries is August 19. Classes may be added for pre-entered ponies on show day before 8am each day. Those wishing to enter after the closing date will pay a \$50 late fee and must make arrangements with the secretary.
14. ALL horses MUST show proof of Negative Coggins dated within the current year. Foals at dam's side are covered under the dam's test. This is MN state law.
15. All animals coming from states other than MN and WI MUST bring proof of health certificate dated within past 30 days.
16. Stallions may be shown in all performance classes except youth classes, but MUST be under control. Unruly animals will be excused from ring.
17. All animals must be serviceably sound. In case of unsoundness, judge may have animal excused from ring.
18. The show committee, Minnesota Gypsy Horse Club, Double F Arena and their employees are not responsible for accidents of any kind or loss of personal property or damage of any kind.
19. All attendees of horses will be subject to the order of the show and MUST have animals ready to enter the ring when required. If you have delays, you must contact the ring steward. Tack changes where needed.
20. Any animal on a trail or other obstacle course before the class, will be eliminated from the competition. Courses may be walked by riders or drivers only.
21. **NO DOGS ALLOWED in the barns** except for certified service dogs. Dogs are allowed outside the barn and in trailers/trucks only.
22. **NO TYING OF HORSES/PONIES TO RAILINGS, WALLS, OR FENCES!** This is a facility rule and will result in removal from show grounds!
23. Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show grounds.
