Jan 11 - petition to renew all 3 schools, and request to add additional local site  $\rightarrow$  Material Revision, which is reviewed separately from renewal

Proposed Add'l Sites: Santa Clara Pob Dept, Sac County Jail, Sac Probation Dept, SLO County Jail; SLO County Prob Dept

- Large percentage of ADA of 3 combined > 80% comes from outside of SF county (as far as Sonoma to LA)
- Property tax related to charter schools excess ERAF costing SF County to fund ADA for 5 Keys generated outside of SF

Recommended Next Steps:

- withdraw additional sites request
- Recommendation to BOE 3/22

Gov Budget Proposal - Trailer Bill for upcoming budget - cap population for 21-22 budget for >24v/o

5 Keys - amount of ADA is down b/c COVID, etc.

Q: 5 Keys should apply under LAUSD jurisdiction since they have more operating sites there | A: b/c of Trailer Bill, there are obstacles for them to apply under current renewal petition; can't tell BOE to deny and review elsewhere, need to review under the criteria that is available

Prop 39 Facilities Requests: 2021-22

2 preliminary offers for New School SF to stay at Sara B Cooper; Kipp Bayview - negotiate deal to lessen impact on bret harte over the next 2 years, but cant commit to longterm rn only current charter term - safe bet that they will be renewed, and anticipate to house them over th next 5 years

At least weekly negotiation sessions in lieu of prop 39 agreement (RIP Michael's sanity)

#### 5:20 - 5:30 Complaints Against Charter Schools

- 1. 5 keys thru a variety of means is inflating their attendance accounting, particularly ADA in independent study programs thru means of alternating or falsifying records + management coercion involved in having the certificated staff in reporting the time spent on ISP for students incorrectly to inflate ADA → receive more funding from the state than entitled to
  - a. Reviewed allegations and prepared a communication to 5 Keys that falls under ed code 47.03 (?) charter school must respond w fiscal requests
  - b. Michael reached out to 5 Keys and detailed request for ADA accounting, audit of ISP and attendance
- 2. 5 Keys the 501c3 is engaging in self-dealing and other various corrupt practices as a nonprofit entity; still being advised on how to proceed
