Allow each group to discuss and come up with their answers.</li> <li>Sample Activities per Theme (Select 1 activity): <ul> <li>Role-playing: Have students act out scenarios where they demonstrate compassion and resolve conflicts peacefully.</li> <li>Poster Making: Provide materials for students to create posters promoting peace and compassion in their community.</li> <li>Interactive Activities: Play games that emphasize teamwork, empathy, and understanding.</li> <li>Group Discussions: Engage students in discussions about real-life examples of positive and negative peace in their community.</li> </ul> </li></ul>
Class Reflection	2 minutes	Gather the students back together and ask each group to share one key insight or action point from their discussion. Encourage students to listen attentively and respectfully to their classmates' ideas.
