

The HUMAN of the Bible Reflection for the month of August - Thaddeus, A Disciple of Jesus.

Thaddeus was known by the name Judas (not Iscariot), in the writings of John, the disciple. Matthew and Mark referred to him as Thaddeus, and Luke called him Judas, son of James. In my research, I learned that Judas was a common name. Thaddeus was a nickname and it meant gentle soul that has a tender child-like heart.

This clearly explains why Thaddeus was a quiet unassuming human. With this restrained demeanor, Jesus saw him and chose him to be one of His disciples. There is not much mentioned about him in Scripture. He is listed as one of Jesus's disciples.

Matthew 10:1-4 KJV

And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

- 2 Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother;
- 3 Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James the son of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus;
- 4 Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him.

Thaddeus was a nickname and it meant gentle soul that has a tender child-like heart.

Each one of Jesus's disciples had a unique personality and character. Some are discussed more than others – so much so that it can seem as though we know them personally. Unfortunately, others are not known as well and do not have much shared about their relationship with Jesus or their ministry in Scripture.

if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.

if I settle on the far side of the sea,
10 even there your hand will guide me,
your right hand will hold me fast.
