Housing:

Leave Requests and Approvals:

We have implemented the **REACH School Boarding System**. **REACH** coordinates leave request procedures for school staff, parents, hosts and boarders. **REACH** will automate all boarder leave request procedures. It will allow you to approve or reject leave requests, submitted by your child, through an email that you will receive. **The Process:** A student will create a request to leave campus through the **REACH** system. Based on our school community procedures, you will be asked (via automated email) to verify and give permission for a particular leave. You will grant this permission through an email that **REACH** will send to you.

Breaks/Holidays:

For the following breaks, the school will be closed, and all students must leave the campus. Hosting solutions and process can be found in our ResLife Student Handbook. It is best practice to begin applying for a host as soon as you have identified your needs for the academic year to allow the proper time needed in selecting a host that best fits your student's needs.

- **Thanksgiving Break:** The dorms close at 12pm on November 18th and reopen at 3pm on November 26th
- **Christmas Break:** Dorms close at noon on December 16th and reopen at 3pm on January 3rd
- **Spring Break:** Dorms close at noon on March 8th and reopen at 3pm on March 17th
- **End of Year:** Dorms close at noon on May 24th
