

## SPECIAL BOARD MEETING

May 14, 2022 / 9:00 AM - 9:45 AM

- I. CALL TO ORDER
  - A. President J. Walsh called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM.
- II. ROLL CALL
  - A. Board Present: J. Walsh President;, M. White, K.Foote, J. Richie Directors
  - B. Not Present: R. Guidi
  - C. **Staff Present**: J. Peri Chief; S. Folsom Bookkeeper; T. Bisson Water Rescue; C. Crosby Administrative Specialist.; J. Glazier EMS
- III. ADOPTION OF AGENDA
  - A. The agenda was adopted by all members
- IV. NEW BUSINESS
  - A. J. Peri presented the preliminary budget for 2022/2023
    - 1. Budget committee met 2 weeks ago to have preliminary discussion.
    - 2. Today is a review of the budget as it currently stands. Some areas are still being finalized.
      - a) Significant ERAF funds are still to be reflected
      - b) Special Public Funds include Burton Fund, TOT, Reserve carry forwards
      - c) MWPA coming in higher. Need to spend, but have some environmental hold ups. \$32K being carried over from 21/22. Sitting on \$69,186 which is being allocated to defensible space and employee salaries.
    - 3. TOT going up again now that short term rentals are being allowed again.
    - 4. \$75K budgeted for the new Firehouse. Not spent in 21/22. \$30K is in the budget for 22/23
    - 5. The Fuel System is still a question. Working on finalizing the solution (and budget) to the current problems.
    - J. Peri would like to see SBVFA funds pay for some upcoming equipment and PPE. Some concern was expressed by J. Ritchie that if community support is needed for a donation push to build the new firehouse, it would be best to not exhaust the community.
    - 7. Reserves: MWPA 10% local and 10% for Chipper days or Defensible space inspections. Reserver for Water Rescue Ski. Before next fiscal year we will work to incorporate ideas from K. Foote's experience in Mill Valley
    - 8. \$66,600 is the total reserve. Sitting at 5%. Down from previous years. To offset this there is a significant amount of reserves from the previous years.
  - B. Research CD investments
    - 1. J. Walsh had a conversation with a volunteer (J. Hyland) who thinks we can get 2.5% by investing our reserves in CDs. S. Folsom thinks this is a good plan if possible.
    - 2. J. Walsh will keep the board informed of progress
  - C. Marin Clean Energy
    - 1. Update on status of contract for Solar Energy Storage System for Community Center and Fire House
      - a) T. Bisson discussed the changes to the contract requested by our council. All were addressed and presented as a clean contract and as a redline in this board meeting.
    - 2. Review and approval of contract\*

- a) Community Center approved the contract as currently written last week
- b) T. Bisson explained that the new batteries should bring down our PGE bills during peak usage.
- c) J. Walsh noted that the contract needs to properly identify parties to change "Stinson Beach Fire" to "Stinson Beach Fire Protection District".
- d) M. White moved to approve the Enerlogics contract with the party change.. J. Walsh seconded. None opposed
- D. Duty Officer Quarters Refresh
  - 1. Review of bids and approval to move ahead with project\*
    - a) Budget of \$15,311 was approved for new floors, kitchen cabinets, plumbing for dishwasher, and touch up painting
    - b) Move to approve by J. Walsh. Seconded by K. Foote. None opposed.
- E. Fill Committee Vacancies (Marin Clean Energy, MWPA)
  - 1. J. Ritchie has offered to fill one position. R. Guidi will fill the other. Both to be decided in the next board meeting.
- V. MEETING ADJOURNMENT
  - A. J. Walsh moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:45 AM. M. White seconded.

NOTE TO PUBLIC: At this close of this Special Board Meeting the Stinson Beach Fire Protection District directors held an executive session to discuss personnel matters related to public employee positions [Ca.
