Being is an abstract adventure game that explores, from a future lens, the past and present of the Palestinian lived experience. The player controls an avatar from the distant future of Palestine on a mission to recover artifacts, memories, and messages from a mysterious house near an old border. The game's aspiration is to convey various aspects of living as a Palestinian during the past century, ranging from perpetual grief to enduring hope.

Being was a part of Art Palestine International x Babycastles exhibition, Over the Rainbow, which showcased Palestinian art resonating out of the unique and valuable lived experiences of Palestinians -- both in the region and the diaspora. The show ran from March 16th to April 17th, 2017.

The video game Being was a part of Art Palestine International x Babycastles exhibition, Over the Rainbow, which showcased Palestinian art resonating out of the unique and valuable lived experiences of Palestinians -- both in the region and the diaspora.

This is a companion comic to Being; it expands on the universe in which Being takes place, and unpacks thoughts on possible Palestinian futures. The Being comic boldly imagines a Palestinian future involving space travel, queerness, and postgenderism.

LGBTQIA+ Activism in Palestine

Date: April 2021

The Palestinian independent researcher and activist Adam Haj Yahia has been involved in grassroots organizing and community building initiatives, concerned with feminist, queer, and anti-colonial movements and communities in Palestine. In recent years, LGBTQIA+ issues have been increasingly discussed in mainstream media and society, leading to an acceleration in change and a shift in dynamics. In his research, Adam looks at how LGBTQIA+ Palestinians navigate through online platforms since then, and which parts of their identities and views they choose to disclose for anti-colonial, political, and social reasons.

For this event, Adam will give insight into the political and colonial frameworks in Palestine and how they intersect with LGBTQIA+ folks' lives and queer issues. We will also learn about the ways in which queer politics in the Palestinian context differ from the more liberal/individualistic ones in western societies and how it is crucial to discuss these politics through an intersectional lens.

Walaa Alqaisiya – Queer Feminism in Palestine

This talk will draw on Walaa Alqaisiya's work with Palestinian queer grassroots activism to discuss the political and conceptual urgency of centering settler-colonialism to gender and sexuality issues in the context of Palestine, the MENA region, and beyond. In doing so, the talk will take the recent uprising and political events in Palestine as a prism to view and understand the context and historical location of Palestinian queer feminist organizing and the decolonial lens they advance.

Queer Palestinian Solidarity: A Lavender Lunch with Tarek Abuata

Date: March 2021

Growing up in Bethlehem, Palestine, Tarek Abuata immigrated with his family to the United States during the first Intifada when he was 11. After graduating from the University of Texas Law School, Tarek started his career working for the Negotiations Support Unit in Palestine researching legal and policy issues. Following this, Tarek worked for 9 years as the Coordinator of Christian Peacemaker Teams in Hebron and also served as the representative of Rev. Bernard LaFayette (a protégé of Martin Luther King) for 5 years, training Palestinian youth in grassroots organizing and activism. Abuata then served for 5 years as the Executive Director of Friends of Sabeel North America. A queer Arab immigrant, Abuata's justice theology is centered on turning the story into revolution for the purpose of collective liberation.

This webinar discusses the intersecting struggles against heteropatriarchy and Zionism as part of the political education curriculum connecting freedom struggles from the U.S. to Palestine called Freedom Bound: Resisting Zionism & White Supremacy at uscpr.org/freedom-bound

Queer and trans Palestinians, like all queer and trans people of color, are fighting for justice on multiple fronts. One of those fronts is combating Israel's weaponization of mainstream LGBTQIA rights advocacy against Palestinians through pinkwashing. Pinkwashing is a tactic used by the Israeli government to transform public perception of Israel from an oppressive regime to a gay-friendly paradise by juxtaposing a falsely progressive image of Israel with a racist portrayal of Palestinian, Arab, and/or Muslim societies as backwards, repressive, and intolerant.

When we look at the world through an intersectional lens, it becomes clear that Palestine is a queer struggle just as it is a feminist struggle, an indigenous struggle, and an antiracist struggle. One cannot be an advocate for queer and trans people in the US while supporting Israel's daily aggression against queer and trans Palestinians, whose oppression is compounded by multiple marginalized identities. As Palestinian Queers for Boycott, Divestment, Sanctions point out, "Israeli oppression, racism, and discrimination does not distinguish between Queer Palestinians and Heterosexual Palestinians."

Only when we see the connections between global systems of oppression, and commit ourselves to struggling together for liberation for all, can we truly build the power and vision we need for a better world.

Queer Palestinian Herstory by Madam Tayoush

A performance lecture narrated by Madam Tayoush that tells a story of Palestinian queerness and how it has evolved throughout the years. This merging of a performance and visiting artist lecture will incorporate personal experiences as a queer performer at some of the top US institutions as well as the development of their practice within the whole Palestinian queer herstory.

Elias Wakeem is a gender queer artist and activist, who mixes languages, changes characters and plays different identities, using grotesque body forms that help him create a scene, which challenges the boundaries existing in his society. They use installation and performance art events that present the mixture of their various characters and personas while examining the reaction of the audience to their personal story.

Madam Tayoush is the "Other" major character that Elias plays. She is one magnificent drag queen performer and entertainer who is full of glam and life. She's here to bring joy and realness in front of her audience. She carries a message of empathy and love through self-fulfilment and artivism.
