

ODual-Hand Picking Challenge — Official Rules

The Challenge:

The same lock must be single pin picked (SPP) to a full open using one hand to control the pick and the other to control the tension tool, and then picked again to a full open with the tool roles reversed, all in one continuous, uncut take.

Video Requirements

- The entire attempt must be recorded in one continuous take, including gutting if required
- No cuts or edits are allowed
- The two required openings must not exceed 10 minutes in total (Gutting portion of the video may exceed 10 minute mark)

Picking Requirements

- Only single pin picking (SPP) is allowed (No raking, zipping, bypasses, etc.)
- For both attempts, one hand must control the pick while the other controls the tension tool
- After the first successful open, the lock must be returned to a fully locked state
- For the second open, tool roles must be reversed (the hand that held the pick must now control tension, and vice versa).

Attempt Integrity

- Between the two required opens, the lock must be fully relocked and tools may be removed and repositioned

Lock Requirements

- Lock must be LPU Green Belt level or higher
- The same lock must be used for both hands/attempts
- The lock must begin in a fully locked state for each attempt
- If the lock is designed to be non-destructively gutted, it must be gutted on camera in the same continuous video
- Excessive master wafering (e.g., heavily mastered training locks) may be rejected at discretion

Visibility Requirements

- The lock must remain clearly visible at all times
- The full picking process must be observable
- If a gut of the lock is required, the lock and its components (pins, springs, etc) cannot leave the frame for the full gutting process

Submission

- Submit a link to your video via the official submission form (<https://forms.gle/U6KHBURhLmX8p1rDA>)
- Provide the lock used and your preferred name for the certificate

Final Determination

- All submissions are reviewed for adherence to both the rules and the spirit of the challenge
- Any attempt that does not meet these standards may be rejected
