## **Cost Sharing Options:**

- 1. The best option is for the non-payroll school to send half the amount supporting the teacher and champion FOR THE SUMMER ONLY to the 'payroll' school (the school where the teacher is currently employed during the school year). The 'payroll school' then pays the entire amount for the Academy teacher and champion.
  - How to Transfer Funds
  - When to Transfer Funds: Right away, when you get your Initial Budget or meet with your Budget Director. New Visions will inform Budget Directors of the need to do this. Remember, you can only transfer TL FSF. Once approved by the Budget, Director, funds should appear in the Receiving (payroll) school within a day.
  - What the Payroll School Will See: Funds will appear in TL FSFSchool to School Transfer in AC Totals.
- 2. Another option is for the payroll school (the teacher's home school) to pay, and for the other school to purchase something of equal value now or later, and have it delivered to the other school. This is an option when the Payroll school only has funds in Contract for Excellence or other grant funds that cannot be transferred.
