# Our learning focus for the term:

This term we will be launching our Inquiry Unit called

'3,2,1, Blast Off! The Sun, Moon and Stars'

The main focus of this inquiry will be how the Sun and Moon affect the planet Earth and the cultural significance of Matariki to New Zealand from a Māori perspective. In alignment with Matariki we will also be exploring the Stars and how people use them.

This will be followed up by a visit to The Stardome Observatory in Week 9.

By the end of this inquiry students will be able to articulate their learning by sharing their knowledge of features and facts that are specific to each celestial body and their impact on Earth and us as people.

#### **Blogs and Reports**

We will be continuing with e-Portfolios as a means of keeping you up to date with your child's learning. It would be fantastic if you could log on and comment on what you see, using your parent login.
