- The more kids that are able to pass their courses, the fewer students we will have to help recover in order to make their graduation date
- English 3 likes that it is included in this, to allow for more buy-in to meeting the goal.
- All members were in favor, no members opposed using this as a goal for all staff in the PDP goals.
- 2.7 points are all that's needed to rate us as a B rated school.
