 - At the November meeting, discuss the business community and Friends of the Library groups. ACTION Bill to consider strategies Terri to add to the November subcommittee agenda.
 - ACTION Terri to draft script for discussions with community organizations for review at next meeting (what would these organizations value? Are there mutually beneficial opportunities?).
 - Holiday Concert for senior citizens was a successful outreach activity in past years.
 Agreed to consider running it again if possible. ACTION Bill to discuss with Randy
 O'Keefe and report back at the November meeting.
 - Small Town Heroes Awards heavy lifting for this was done by the Student Council.
 Agreed to ask if the Council would like to do this again in 2021-2022. ACTION Patti to query President of the Student Council
