Dear Parents:



Research has shown that when parents and other Christian adults both teach a child, he or she is much more likely to walk with Jesus as an adult. Another predictor of lasting faith is whether parents talk about faith at home. In fact, the prophet Moses encouraged parents to weave conversations about God into the fabric of family life (Deuteronomy 6:6-8).

This sounds complicated, but it's quite easy to learn, especially when you lean on friends from your local church. To start we wanted to encourage you to ask your child(ren) what they are learning in Released Bible Time. We also thought we'd share a couple resources to start the conversation and keep it going. 
