Guidance to References

- The referee does not have to be from within the same discipline as the applicant (although preferable) but must be from the same domain of expertise (nutrition, S&C, physiology, psychology).
- Candidates should avoid any conflicts of interest in relation to the references selected. Where there is a potential conflict of interest between the referee and the candidate, this should be highlighted to the ISESA office for guidance ahead of application submission.
- At least one reference should be composed by a mentor. The additional references can come from a coach, manager or athlete. For example, one from a Line Manager/Supervisor (preferably ISESA Accredited, but not essential), and the remaining two from a professional associate/peer* and/or client.
*Peers from a multidisciplinary team would be accepted as long as they are not managed by or accountable to the applicant.
- References from an individual the applicant directly line manages will not be accepted.
- References from clients under the age of 18 will not be accepted. In the case of academy/youth staff, co-workers could be viewed as clients if they are a recipients/beneficiaries of the applicants knowledge and skills.
