- "Ivor had a run of bad luck at the Piñata races. But I'd trust him with my money, if I had any." (Classic only)
- "Sometimes, Bart can change something he's already changed into another new thing. Do you understand?"
- "I'm sure people would like Seedos more if he gave away more seeds. You should try to knock some sense into him."
- "My dad was such a good gardener, because he enjoyed working here. If you aren't enjoying your garden, change it into something else. Something that you really like."
- "Seedos runs much faster since you started to get seeds from him.
 You're keeping him fit!"
- "I find it a mystery how a Sprinkling can carry so much water."
- "I've got two brothers and a sister you know. I was always the brains of the family."

"Oh dear, your garden is full of piñata. If you want to romance piñata and hatch an egg, you'll need to reduce the garden population."

"Hey there, you are growing a plant that's being stunted. This can lead to part or all of the plant not growing at all. To avoid this you should remove the blockage as soon as possible, and in future plant your seeds away from objects that could cause this problem again."

"What's this? A Beggar! He must have heard about your ever increasing garden value. You should deal with immediately."

"Let me introduce Dastardos. He loves smashing open sick piñata and stealing their sweets. He's very difficult to stop, if only you could make the piñata well, then he wouldn't try to get their sweets."

"Oh dear, one of your Piñatas has been trampled! Naturally, this will make them unhappy."

"There's a fight. Even good - natured piñata sometimes find a neighbour they just can't get along with. Fights are trouble, because one side always ends up getting hurt."

"One of your plants is too dry. When plants haven't got enough water, they change to a brown colour. If you water them, they will recover. If you leave them without water too long, they will die."

"Careful now! One of your plants is being over-watered. When plants have too much water they change to a blue colour. If you stop watering them they will recover, but if you water them too much, they will die. So keep an eye on them." "A sour piñata is ready to change! The sour has gone into a cocoon where it will change into it's tame form."

"You've unlocked a new chapter in the storybook! You can read it in the Journal."

"A piñata has broken open. When piñata lose their sweets like this they return to the wild - outside the garden. It's part of life here on Piñata Island. You can't become a GREAT gardener, without breaking a few piñatas."

"Next time you put the cursor over a piñata you'll notice the happy meter. The happy meter tells you about your piñata's mood. Every time something happens to the piñata the triangles turn orange or turn blue. The ore orange triangles a piñata has the happier it is, and you can see this on the face in the middle."

"Now Costalat's is onen you can buy romance sweets. If you have romanced a

"Now Costalot's is open you can buy romance sweets. If you have romanced a piñata species before, you can replace all their requirements (except their house) with a romance sweet. Buy a sweet and direct a piñata to it. They should eat it and instantly they will have a heart appear over their head to show they are ready to romance. This should make romancing piñatas easier. Remember that both piñatas will need a sweet."

"The village General Store is now open. Remember those chocolate coins you collected the other day? Now you can spend them at the store. When you get back to your garden press X to open the main menu and select the village option. Then you can choose to visit any store or service that is open for business."

"A hunt has started! The piñata food chain means that sometimes the bigger, cute and papery piñatas feed on the smaller, cute and papery piñatas. You may be able to stop a hunter by dousing it with water, whacking it with your shovel, or keeping it away from it's dinner by building a good strong fence."

"Your gardening is improving! Well done! You just seem to get better and better."

"Let me introduce Seedos. He's obsessed with gathering seeds. You should try talking to him."

"You've levelled up! You filled the petals around the clock which means you've taken a step closer to becoming a truly great gardener. All kinds of things happen when you become a better gardener, new shops open, new items appear in the shops, new piñatas will want to visit, new characters appear and Seedos will have new seeds in his pouch."

"Here are the experience petals. Can you see them around the clock? When you do something to help the garden the petals will turn blue. If you'd like some more information about the experience petals press Y or look in the Journal. Now let's see how many experience points you have gained from your work so far."

"Here is your clock. From now on you can see what time it is in the garden. Some gardeners use their clock to predict which wild piñata will show up."

"You seem to have most of the basics now so see what you can do with the rest of the day before the sun goes down. (I'd suggest you try to romance enough whirlms to earn your first Master Romancer award!)"

"The next time you put the cursor over a plant you'll notice the water meter. It shows how much water a plant has. You can use the water meter to make sure conditions are perfect for the plant to grow."

"Well done, you've planted your seed but you'll need to water it to help it grow. Without water the plant will turn yellowy-brown and die. If your plant starts turning blue you're giving it too much water, which can also kill it. Go back to the garden by pressing A then press X to find your 'new' watering can."

A baby piñata is ready to grow up! The baby goes into a cocoon where it grows to it's adult size. When it has grown it will hatch out as a young adult. If you get impatient you can give the cocoon some 'encouragement' with your shovel." You've got two sparrowmint residents now. That's good work. The next stage is to get them to Romance. Open the menu and look in the Journal or you can put the cursor on a sparrowmint and press Y for information.

The 'Current Status' tab shows you what you need to do next."

"Every time a new piñata is hatched in your garden, your label is fixed to it. You can change your label by using the Label Designer from the Main Menu. Press A to close this Alert, bring up the menu with X and then select the Label Designer icon."

"Now that you have provided the whirlms with everything they need, the hearts above their head show they are ready to romance. To begin put your cursor over any whirlm."

"Did you see the colour change? The whirlm has become a RESIDENT! It likes your garden so much it's going to stay here. Try naming your new resident. Just close this alert with A, put away any tool you have open and place the cursor over your whirlm."

"Take this GRASS SEED PACKET as a reward for getting your first visiting Whirlm piñata. It never runs out of seeds! Press A to close this alert then press X for the menu. Choose your new grass seed packet from there."

"You've uncovered some coins. When you put the cursor near chocolate coins, you will automatically pick them up. You can spend them later - we have things to do before the shop opens."

"Alerts will wait down here for you to look at them. If something is very important, the alert will open automatically. If you have more than one alert you can choose with one to open by moving the cursor over alerts with the left stick. When you've finished with the alert bar press up on the D-pad to put the cursor back into the garden."

"Since you've just started here, why don't you see if you can help Langston out. He'll point you in the right direction until you find your feet." (TiP only)

"Because you've become a Master Romancer or tamed a sour, you've unlocked an extra design in the tag editor." (TiP only)

"A Wildcard is a very special Piñata, but two together is an amazing event!" (TiP only?)

"A new Piñata has been spotted in the Piñarctic." (TiP only)

"Hi, I'm Leafos and I'm going to help you get started. Look for this:(ANNOYING TARGET SYMBOL FROM TIP). It can show up anywhere, but it always tries to tell you where to go and what to do next." (TiP only) "Hello there! Welcome to Just for Fun mode! This is where you go to do whatever you want in a special garden where everything's open for you to play with. The only goal is to enjoy yourself, so go ahead and have fun!" (TiP only) If you need a little help getting started, head over to Langston in the village by pressing X. I hear he has some important helpful advice to kick start your garden!" (TiP only)

Whacked

- "If you try to hit me once more I shall teach you a lesson!"
- "That's it! I warned you let's see how you get on without your shovel for a while!" (Classic only)
- "Don't you ever learn? Hit me once more, and just watch what I do this time!" (TiP only)

 "Right! I warned you - have this peice of junk instead of your lovely shovel!" (TiP only)

Watered

- "I decide when I need a wash. If you can't control that watering can I shall take it from you."
