
## **Wildflower Designs**

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Wildflower Designs (163325) or Bundled (163334)
- Cardstock (CS) and Paper: Pretty In Pink (163783); Basic White Thick (159229); 2024-202 In Color 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper (DSP) (163777)
- **Stamp Pads:** Pretty In Pink (163807); Gray Granite (147118)
- Tools: Stampin' Cut & Emboss
  Machine (149653); Wildflower Designs
  Dies (163333) or Bundled (163334);
  Paper Trimmer (152392); Eyelet
  Embossing Folder (163414)
- Miscellaneous: Iridescent Faceted Gems (163368); Stampin'





## Measurements:

- Basic White Thick 4 ¼" x 11" scored at 5 ½"; 3 ¾" x 5" (2); 5/8" x 4" & 2 x 3 ½"
- 2024-2026 In Color DSP ½" x 6" (2 each of 3 different colors).

## Instructions:

- 1. Attach the DSP strips horizontally to one of the 3 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 5" pieces of Basic White Thick cardstock with Stampin' Seal Adhesive. Trim edges off with Paper Trimmer.
- **2.** Emboss the above piece of cardstock using the Eyelet Embossing Folder and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine.
- 3. Using the Wildflower Design Dies cut shape (and cut it in half) to stamp flower on. After stamping the flower in Gray Granite ink, color it with the Stampin' Blends and attach it to the embossed cardstock with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- **4.** Stamp sentiment in Pretty In Pink ink onto the 5/8" x 4" piece of white cardstock and attach to card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- **5.** Tie a double strand of Linen Thread into a bow around the bottom of the stamped image, holding it in place with a Mini Glue Dot.
- 6. Add Iridescent Faceted Gems.
- 7. Attach three strips of dsp to envelope and trim with Paper Trimmer.
