Literature review

This section contains referred literature and linked to the research and hypothesis development. This section contains about theory and literature referenced and linked to writing. Highly recommended that literature referenced is published the last 5 years with the following order: are puted international journals, national journals accredited national journals, international symposiums, national symposiums, textbooks and daily repute.

Research Methods

Methods are implemented to solve problems, including analytical methods. The method used to solve the research problems is described in this section. **(For Conceptual Ideas Without Research Method).**

Results and Discussion

This section consists of results and discussion. Every result should be supported by sufficient data. Then, the result should be able to answer the research question or hypothesis stated earlier in the introduction.

Conclusion

Conclusion states the answer of the hypothesis and/or research objective or scientific finding. Conclusion is not the repetition of findings and discussion, but it is the summary of findings as expected in the objective or hypothesis. If necessary, conclusion can also be ended with the next idea to be implemented to the study.

Acknowledgement are primarily addressed to research funders or donors. Acknowledgement can also be dedicated to people who contribute to the study.
