**Benchmark Testing for Grades 3-5-** Our 3-5 grade Coyotes will be taking a Semester Benchmark Test in Reading and Math from 1/23-1/31. The purpose of the benchmark assessments is to inform classroom teachers about student mastery of recently instructed content and will be used to monitor pacing, differentiate instruction, and identify resources needed to prepare our end of year SOL Tests in the spring. The test will not be used as a grade.
