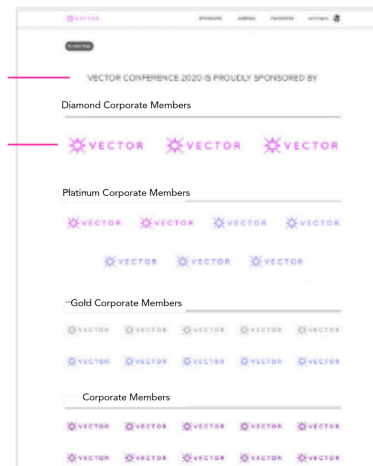
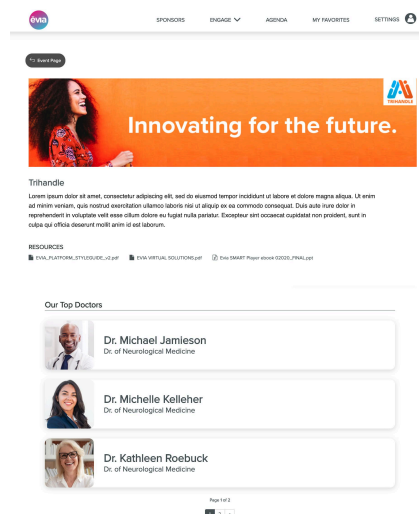


## Virtual Exhibit Information

- **Meeting Platform:**
  - **Evia - Virtual Exhibit Page - attendee directed information exchange**
    - We will be updating the virtual exhibit page from last year as a starting point - please submit any edits **ASAP, no later than Wednesday, March 10th**.
    - From the main event page, there will be a link in the top navigation bar to Virtual Exhibits
    - This will bring up the tiered corporate member page (your company's logo will be listed underneath the appropriate corporate member section, and that logo will link to your virtual booth page as detailed in the PDF below)



- Page will be live to registered participants who login to the Evia meeting platform
- Chat functionality can be turned off on each individual page if not desired - this is a static, public chat, so please plan accordingly. As you can see in the example below, there is no white space if you choose not to utilize chat or video - it simply goes to the next section.



- Corporate members are under no obligation to provide any information compliance does not support.
- Resource documents (in the Resources Section) do not have file size limits, but please be mindful of attendee download times.
- Screen capture of page setup in advance of opening to attendees is possible for compliance review.

- **Gatherly Spatial Video Chat Platform:**
  - If you're not familiar with Gatherly, check out <https://www.gatherly.io/faqs/getting-started>
  - Integrated into Evia platform (same as October meeting but with some user interface improvements)
  - Discussion is private and not recorded - only those in the chat are privy to the discussion and there is no way for someone to listen in (see <https://www.gatherly.io/faqs/security>)
  - You may "share screen" with someone you are in a video chat with, so if you've got a resource you want to show, you simply click on the share screen and you're good to go! When you screen share, it still shows your video feed (but just smaller and at the bottom of the screen). The screenshare button is available at the bottom of the screen (near the mute button) whenever you're in a huddle with someone.
  - You may also share links in the chat window with everyone in your video chat or a particular attendee

  - There are some user interface enhancements underway with Gatherly that may be available by the time of our meeting - to the best of my knowledge, tablets are not yet officially supported.
