

ADMINISTRATION IN POLICY ABSENCE

In situations where action must be taken by the school division and the School Board has not adopted a policy nor provided guidelines for administrative action, the superintendent has the power to act, but the superintendent's decisions are subject to review by the School Board at its next regular meeting. It is the duty of the superintendent to inform the School Board promptly of such action taken and of the need for policy.
