

2nd Quarter 2022 Report
For 4th District

The following is a report of District and Post activities conducted and planned during the 2nd quarter. A luncheon and meeting was held on 04/23/2022 hosted by the District's Ladies Auxiliary at Fremont WI. Posts 7, 13, 30 and 45 were represented, with Post 1212 representation absent.

Previously proposals for amendments to the District's CBL were discussed and voted on by the members present. District Judge Advocate Armin Conradt will be preparing a revised CBL for approval at the July meeting.

The members present also discussed the plans for the District to hold a Hospitality Suite at the Department Convention. Members present decided not to pursue this at the present time.

At the meeting Post 30 announced its intention to "abstain" from participation in Department and some District activities until the Department produces documents that have been requested in regards to a past lawsuit involving Post 1128 and that the Department proves it is in full compliance with its CBL. Post 30 will remain in compliance with Post validation requirements.
