### Directions:

  - **Partially Trash Free Lunch:** at least one item packed are reusable
  - **No Trash Free Lunch:** no items packed are reusable – all are disposable/single use
- A Trash Free Lunch is one in which all packed items can be eaten, reused, or composted (i.e. Lunch box, water bottle, snack and food containers, whole fruit, utensil, napkin) and there are no single use items or packaging.
