# P to 4 - ACC Student Technology Requirements

ACC supports Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) by incorporating **Apple** devices at our schools. This document outlines the Hardware, Software and Application requirements for students on their IPADS.

#### iPad Hardware - Prep to Year 4

Anyone of the following iPad models is suitable to the BYOD program:

- iPad Pro 12.9-inch (2nd generation and later)
- iPad Pro 10.5-inch
- iPad Pro 11-inch (1st generation and later)
- iPad Air (3rd generation and later)
- iPad (7th generation and later)

Please note: iPad Mini (all models) devices are not accepted by NAPLAN due to the compatibility of the lockdown browser.

- For those students completing NAPLAN testing, headphones are required in addition to the device.
- It is advised that a suitable IPAD case or cover (No larger than 23CM in total width, for classroom management) should be purchased to protect the device.

TIP: If your child is starting at Year 4, consider transitioning to a Macbook Air for a cost-benefit to your family for the following year in Year 5.

### **Application Requirements**

All Ipads are required to have the following apps installed and managed by ACC parents. Parents will need to set up an <u>Apple ID</u> to facilitate downloading these apps and maintain app updates during their students time in P to 4.

Parents will also need to exclude the following apps from <u>Screen time</u> restrictions where possible, to ensure each app works during school hours.

#### **IPAD IOS Updates**

All iPads should have the latest IPadOS (Device operation system) installed (Version 17.4.1 released Mar 2024) available via the software update process:

**STEPS:** Settings - General - Software Update - Download and install - Enter passcode - reboot when prompted.

If your iPad doesn't have or receive **the latest update**, the device may potentially be too old and not listed on page 1 of this document.


