There are two folders currently on our Schoology page; one folder is titled "Summer Assignments" and contains all of your summer assignments organized by due date, the second folder is titled "APUSH Materials." You are welcome to work ahead, but please do not get behind. Late work will be accepted, but there will be a 5-point deduction for each day late. Therefore, reflection papers cannot be more than one day late and chapter work cannot be submitted more than 3 days late in order to receive credit. If you are having a problem completing an assignment, have questions or are dealing with any extenuating circumstances, you MUST communicate with me prior to the due date.

There is A LOT of material to cover and you will be responsible for a considerable amount of independent work, both during the summer and the school year. All assignments must be completed independently; all essays, FRQs, DBQs, and short answer questions will be read thoroughly. Reflection papers involve personal thoughts, ideas and beliefs. There are no right or wrong answers. Therefore, no two reflection papers should be the same. Please READ the assigned chapters and please do not copy definitions from the glossary. Use of Al will not be tolerated and will result in a zero for the assignment.
