August - September	<ul> <li>Develop a list of schools that interest you. Remember it's best to apply to several different schools: reach, good fit, and safety!</li> <li>Begin to think about teacher recommendations.</li> <li>Create a High School Resume. Template is available in the Senior Folder and on Mrs. Froehlich's website.</li> <li>Begin college and scholarship applications.</li> </ul>
October - November	<ul> <li>Meet early action deadlines for college admission applications.</li> <li>Check college portals for missing information</li> <li>Take or re-take the SAT or ACT if needed</li> <li>Fill out the FAFSA (opens on October 1st)</li> <li>Complete RDS if applying to schools in NC</li> <li>Check to see if your college requires the CSS profile (similar to the FAFSA)</li> </ul>
December	Continue checking college portals for any missing requirements.
January - March	<ul> <li>Begin hearing back from some colleges regarding admissions decisions</li> <li>March 1st - priority deadline for financial aid and FAFSA</li> <li>Check SHS website for local scholarships and apply as applicable!</li> </ul>
May	<ul> <li>AP Exams</li> <li>May 1st - National deadline to commit to your college!</li> </ul>
June	<ul><li>Final Exams</li><li>Graduation</li></ul>
