

General Timeline for College Bound Seniors

Month	Action
August - September	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develop a list of schools that interest you. Remember it's best to apply to several different schools: reach, good fit, and safety!• Begin to think about teacher recommendations.• Create a High School Resume. Template is available in the Senior Folder and on Mrs. Froehlich's website.• Begin college and scholarship applications.
October - November	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Meet early action deadlines for college admission applications.• Check college portals for missing information• Take or re-take the SAT or ACT if needed• Fill out the FAFSA (opens on October 1st)• Complete RDS if applying to schools in NC• Check to see if your college requires the CSS profile (similar to the FAFSA)
December	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue checking college portals for any missing requirements.
January - March	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Begin hearing back from some colleges regarding admissions decisions• March 1st - priority deadline for financial aid and FAFSA• Check SHS website for local scholarships and apply as applicable!
May	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• AP Exams• May 1st - National deadline to commit to your college!
June	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Final Exams• Graduation
