NOTES:

Hats may be worn in the winter outside school at playtime but NOT in school

Caps may be worn when it is sunny to protect the children's heads but NOT inside

All hair styles must be securely fixed back for PE lessons and for lessons taking place regarding science and technology.

2. Roles and Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of the Principal to ensure the dress code is publicised to parents and pupils and adhered by pupils and to address promptly any non-compliance of the code using informal procedures where possible but implementing formal procedures where necessary.
