Objective: Research and evaluate mobile devices' storage options to make an informed choice.

Directions:

1. Choose a Mobile Device: Select a phone or laptop that you are interested in researching. Consider using websites like apple.com, bestbuy.com, samsung.com, etc.
 - a. **Type The Name Of The Device Here:**
2. Research the device. Gather the following information:
 - a. **Description of the device**
 - b. **Cost of the device**
 - c. **Identify available storage options (ex. 64GB, 128GB, 256GB).**
 - d. **Which Storage option will you select?**
3. Usage requirements. Determine how you would use this . For example, you would need a lot of storage for apps, games, music, school work etc.
 - a. **Describe how you would use this device.**
 - b. **Would you primarily use the internal storage or would you store your files in another way?**
4. Read reviews from other users to gain insights into their experiences with the device's storage capacity and performance. (You may have to go to google and search for reviews)
 - a. **What do the reviews generally say?**
5. Based on the reviews and your research, would it be a good idea to purchase this device? Why or why not? (Consider things like cost, storage, durability, etc.)
