 - Take a career interest inventory, explore careers and colleges, and take a learning style assessment.
 - Add careers to your list of “Careers and Clusters I’m Thinking About”
 - Add colleges to your list of “Colleges I’m Thinking About”
 - Search for Scholarships (Colleges > Scholarships & Money)
 - View suggested high school courses for careers of interest
 - Add your high school activities, volunteer work, and work experience in your “About Me>My Stuff>Résumé” tab to have your résumé ready for future scholarships & college applications.
- Complete the FAFSA4caster at <https://studentaid.gov/understand-aid/estimate> and/or the EFC Estimator at <https://bigfuture.collegeboard.org/pay-for-college/tools-calculators> with your parents’/guardians’ help to see how affordable college may be for you.
- Complete freshman Scholar Success activities if you are a 21st Century Scholar at www.scholartrack.org. You must also earn a 2.5GPA on the Core 40 diploma track.

- Set high expectations and achieve your goals.
 - Obtain all of your credits.
 - Set a goal GPA appropriate for your future plans.
