This is the list of supplies posted at the start of the course.

- metal ruler or wood ruler with a metal edge
- newsprint pad (30 lb. standard weight), 18" by 24"
- fixative
- drawing paper (60 or 80 lb. standard weight) 18" by 24", at least 30 sheets; recycled paper is acceptable
- a variety of graphite pencils, ranging from HB to 8B
- qum eraser
- kneaded eraser

• Blank, white paper

- o Minimum size should be 8x10". Maximum size of 18x24".
- You can use a sketchbook to easily keep all work together, or loose sheets are fine too.
- Drawing paper is preferred (60-80 lb is standard weight) but you can use printer paper if that is all you have.

A pencil

- Or a smaller set of graphite drawing pencils.
- o Minimum of 3 that include HB, 2B and 4B
- Eraser of any kind (FYI some pencil sets will come with an eraser)
- Pencil sharpener
- A ruler (can be metal, wood or plastic)
 - Or something to help you draw straight lines (the edge of a book or folder will work)
