- Arrival at SharpTop on Sunday (Day 1) will be from 2:00PM – 4:00PM EST. Please make every effort to arrive during these hours.
- Departure on Saturday (Day 7) will be at 2:00PM EST. Please schedule your departure bus to arrive between 12:30pm - 1:00pm EST. If your bus arrives outside of this window, SharpTop will *not* have staff monitoring the driveway for oncoming traffic.
- Be sure to complete your [10-Day Report](#) and [Arrival Form in YLCC](#) on the appropriate due dates. Please also be sure to have health forms for ALL your campers and leaders submitted online prior to arrival.
- Carefully read the program team letter to learn important details regarding events and items to bring.
