Elementary (K-5th) Hybrid and Virtual Learning Model Snapshots Begins: Monday, September 14, 2020

INSTRUCTIONAL OFFERINGS

Preparation

- Families should notify the school of their choice (hybrid/virtual) by Sept. 8th.
- Thursday, Sept. 10th live instruction will end at noon. Recorded lessons and independent work will be posted for Thursday afternoon and all day Friday. This will allow teachers to prepare classrooms for students to be present on Monday, September 14.
- Administrators will collaborate with families to ensure that class rosters are evenly distributed.
- Additional details regarding policies and procedures for students on campus will be prepared and posted on our school website.

Hybrid Learning Model

ON-CAMPUS DAYS (Mon./Tues. OR Thurs./Fri.)

LIVE INSTRUCTION

- Live classroom instruction will focus on Math and ELA.
- Brain breaks will be provided as necessary to transition between lessons and content.

ANCILLARY (MUSIC, ART, PE, LIBRARY)

• Classes will have 2 ancillary time slots each day and will have art, music, PE, and library over the course of the two on-campus days.

SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTION

Classroom teachers will provide small group instruction throughout the school day as needed.

LUNCH & RECESS

- Lunch will be eaten in the classroom.
- Recess will be scheduled at a time and location to allow continuation of static groups
 DEVICES
 - 2nd-5th graders must bring school issued Chromebooks to school each day.
 - K and 1st should NOT bring the school issued Chromebooks and tablets to school each day.

EXTENDED CARE

- Morning and Afternoon extended care will be available for an additional cost.
- No extended care will be available Monday, September 14th and Thursday, September 17th.

VIRTUAL DAYS (Mon./Tues./Wed. OR Wed./Thurs./Fri.)

RECORDED LESSONS/INDEPENDENT WORK

- Six recorded, self-paced lessons will be posted each week.
- Independent practice activities will be posted each week and may be a combination of online learning platforms (ex: Zearn, NearPod, etc.) and paper/pencil based activities.
- Office Hours will be offered for 1 hour every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

SCHEDULE

- The weekly schedule indicates live meet times and suggested times for the recorded lessons/independent work activities.
- Families will have flexibility as to the structure of their days. However, students are expected to meet the posted deadlines for assignments.

LUNCH & RECESS

• Families have flexibility in scheduling their lunch and recess times.

LIVE INSTRUCTIONAL LESSONS

- Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30AM to 12:15PM
- Live lessons will focus on Math and ELA.
- 15 minute breaks will be between each lesson.
- Live lessons will be recorded for students who are unable to attend at the schedule times.

RECORDED LESSONS/INDEPENDENT WORK

- Six recorded, self-paced lessons will be posted each week.
- Independent practice activities will be posted each week and may be a combination of online learning platforms (ex: Zearn, NearPod, etc.) and paper/pencil based activities.
- Office Hours will be offered for 1 hour every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

ANCILLARY (MUSIC, ART, PE, LIBRARY)

Ancillary teachers will post 1 recorded lesson each week for each class.

SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTION

• Small groups will be scheduled by the teachers throughout the day on Wednesday.

SCHEDULE

- The weekly schedule indicates live meet times and suggested times for the recorded lessons/independent work activities.
- Outside of the scheduled meet times and office hours, families will have flexibility as to the structure of their days. However, students are expected to meet the posted deadlines for assignments.

LUNCH & RECESS

• Families will use the weekly schedule to choose times for lunch, recess, and brain breaks that work best for their homes.
