Homecoming 2025 Format

Background: Homecoming 2024 exceeded the appropriate number of representatives. It became necessary for the WSHS Student Council and WSHS Administration to develop a solution to reduce the number of representatives and improve equitability across all clubs and teams.

I. Selection of Homecoming Court:

- Teams:
 - All Fall athletic teams will select one (1) Senior member from their team to be nominated for Homecoming King or Queen.
 - They will also select one (1) at-large member of the Senior class to nominate for Homecoming King or Queen.
 - o Example:
 - Women's tennis selects ONE senior athlete to be nominated for homecoming queen and one senior male to be nominated for homecoming king

Clubs:

 All clubs with fifteen (15) or more members will select one (1) male to be nominated for homecoming king and one (1) female representative to be nominated for homecoming queen

II. Representatives

- All representatives, to be eligible at the time of nomination, must:
 - o Be in good academic standing
 - Must be passing all courses when nominated
 - Comply with the county attendance policy
 - Less than ten (10) absences, per course, for all courses
 - Not have any office referrals.
 - This excludes minor infractions (tardies, cell phone, etc.)

III. Voting:

- Nominations must be submitted to WSHS Student Council advisors no later than two (2) weeks prior to Homecoming. A Google Sheet will be shared with coaches and club advisors to complete this.
- Voting will occur during the week of the Homecoming Football game via electronic student ballot (Google Forms).

IV. Crowning:

- The Homecoming King will be crowned during the Homecoming Pep Rally during the school day closest to the Homecoming Football game.
 - All Homecoming King nominees must be present during the Pep Rally to be eligible to be crowned.
- The Homecoming Queen will be crowned during halftime of the Homecoming Football game.
 - All Homecoming Queen nominees must be present during the ceremony at halftime of the Homecoming Football game.
 - All Queen nominees must follow the established <u>guidelines</u>. Any violations risk the nominee not being allowed to participate in the Crowning ceremony.
