Congratulations on completing an amazing quarter two! I am so proud of the hard work and dedication you've shown. Many of our students have made impressive academic improvements, and we are so close to reaching our on-track goals (which are among the highest in the district). Following the end of Quarter 2, here's how we ended the quarter with our on-track data goals!:

#### Middle School:

- 7th Grade- 30 out of 31- 97% on track. 77% Firmly on Track (Goal 100%)!
- 8th Grade- 43 out of 43- 100% on track. 66% Firmly on Track (Goal 100%)!

### **High School:**

- 9th Grade- 144 out of 182- 76% on track. (up 3%) and 46% Firmly on Track (Goal 50%)!
- 10th Grade- 157 out of 172- 91% on track. (up 11%) Currently Meeting Goal
- 11th Grade- 221 out of 239- 93% on track. (up 18%) Currently Meeting Goal
- 12th Grade- 165 out of 176- 95% on track. (up 1%) (Goal 100%)!
