

Chatham Hills Eagles Fore Good Grant Information & Application - 2026



Last year, Chatham Hills golf members raised more than \$60,000 for local children's charities through Eagles Fore Good. This year we are on pace to exceed \$70,000. We are honored to partner with organizations that make a meaningful difference in the lives of children and families in our community.

*Grants will only be awarded to qualifying 501(c)3 public charities serving children.
Grant awards typically range from \$2,000 - \$7,000.*

Eagles Fore Good Grant Making Principles:

- To make an immediate and long-lasting impact benefiting children facing adversity.
- To enrich the quality of life of children in areas in and around Chatham Hills Country Club.
- To encourage programs which are collaborative, comprehensive, and have the potential to be continuous.

Applicant Organization Criteria:

- Must be a 501(c)3 public charity.
- Must have been established for a minimum of 3 years.
- Must have a specific project or program for which the funding is being requested.
- Must have measurable outcomes for the specific project or program.
- Must submit a summary report as to how the grant money was spent at project completion

What Eagles Fore Good Will (Generally) Not Fund:

While Eagles Fore Good remains flexible in trying to meet needs of local children's charities, the following are areas that will generally not be considered for funding at this time:

- Endowment campaigns
- Existing obligations or debts/liabilities
- Medical research, such as cancer research

- Special fundraising events and sponsorships
- Travel, tours, or trips for employees/board members
- Routine general operating expenses, including administrative salaries
