As parents/guardians of middle school students, it's important to recognize that bullying can significantly impact a child's well-being and academic success. As a school community, we are committed to preventing bullying. Here are some ways parents, teachers, and students can work together:

For Parents/Guardians:

- Open Communication: Create an environment where your child feels comfortable discussing their concerns with you.
- Educate: Teach your child about bullying and the importance of reporting it.
- Set Boundaries: Establish clear rules about technology use and monitor your child's online activities.
- Be a Role Model: Demonstrate respectful and kind behavior in your interactions with others.

For Students:

- Be an Upstander: If you witness bullying, stand up for the victim and report it to a trusted adult. This is something students review in Crew.
- Include Others: Include classmates who may be feeling left out or isolated.
- Online Responsibility: Think before you post or send messages online, and report any
 cyberbullying.
