President's Report: Rebecca Pineault

- Teacher appreciation is the week of May 6th. Will have sign up if anyone wants to help on a specific day of that week.
- Tentative date of 5/17 for spring dance, confirmed gym availability with school.
 - Kristen Nill offered tips from old board: charge for event to at least cover the DJ, maybe a free giveaway of popcorn or something. Maybe a raffle to give away dance tickets, offer tickets to families that might need them (guidance would have them).
 - Liz Klish SEPAC member, inclusivity advisor offered tips for making event inclusive to all. Also advertising that to families. Utilizing OT room, early start time with lights on and music low for instance.
 - Lisabeth Jorgensen making inclusivity ingrained into PTO planning without having a SEPAC member saying it.
 - Vote to have a spring dance: long discussion about a community event loved by all vs the cost of it. No objection to having a dance.
 - Charging per family discussion brought up guidance can give a list of kids who might need financial assistance.
 - Liz asked if we need a police detail depends on numbers, but not if we don't know the numbers ahead/sell at the door.
