For Candidates and Sponsors

Confirmation is a Sacrament that is celebrated with reverence, joy, and dignity. The attire worn by both the Confirmation Candidate and his/her Sponsor should reflect the same.

Attire during the Confirmation Mass, both candidates and sponsors should respect Christian modesty and Church Tradition.

What should candidates and sponsors wear for Confirmation?	
Women	Men
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dress or Skirt and Blouse Hemlines should be within 2 inches of the top of the knee with a modest neckline (no cleavage should be showing); back and shoulders MUST be covered. A shawl, sweater or wrap must be worn over sleeveless dresses. • Dress Pants/Blouse • Dress Shoes (You should be able to walk comfortably; no flip flops of any kind.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dress Pants (No Jeans or Cargo Pants) • Dress Shirt and Tie • Dress Socks and Dress Shoes (no gym socks or shoes) • Suit or Sport Jacket (optional)
<p>Please make sure your forehead is uncovered (free from hair or hair accessories) for Anointing from the Bishop.</p>
