Why is this important

We need to know who the influencers are, and we need to align our outreach and communications with their current narrative. This is one of our most effective prospects for influencing the policies, leaders, and initiatives with the power to realize our mission.

Policy Internship

The Policy Intern is an integral part of Kaiāulu's team.

- Monitors legislation and policy developments relevant to forest conservation
- Summarizes policy developments for a general audience opinions and for Kaiāulu community and Council members
- Assists with the preparation of policy statements, briefing papers and responses to Government consultations
- Tracks policy meetings and events
- Represents Kaiāulu at external meetings where appropriate
- Assists with general administration as required by the Senior Policy Officer

The successful candidate should be educated to degree level or equivalent in ecology, environmental science or a related subject. They have demonstrable knowledge and genuine interest in public policy. A proven interest in ancient forests, indigenous rights and biodiversity is essential. They also need to have excellent communication and IT skills.
