Treasurer's Report:

- We have switched from Kori Matson to Ernie Stokes.
- Account balance is \$21,628.71. This includes student accounts earmarked for them specifically.
- Krispy Kreme fundraiser raised \$1,265 in total profit & includes what goes into student accounts.
- Car wash amount is still being worked on to get student accounts tallied up.
- We have to apply for facility use through the school system and carry liability insurance. Ernie has been updated as contact. Insurance has been renewed and paperwork sent in today.
- First game: \$2,541.79 total expenses which includes items that will be reused
