#### Plan for the Week:

#### Monday:

 Listen or read the story "Where are You From?" Each grade level will get a copy of this book. ### Tuesday:

• Students will complete the "Where Are You From?" Card. They will complete this card at home or in class if time allows, but they may need help from family members to complete. The cards will be pinned onto a large world size map with strings so we can see how beautifully diverse our JDP family is. (Jamie and JJ will purchase the map and we need to find a central spot to hang it - should we do one map per grade level? Or one for the whole school?)

# Wednesday:

 Bring in a picture of themselves, their family and other people who have influenced them to attach to their "Where Are You From?" card.

## Thursday:

- Students can add different traditions from where they are from to their map.
  - Option: Students could write a personal narrative on a tradition they share with their families or research a tradition and create a non-fiction or how-to book, or google slideshow
  - Younger grades could draw pictures to represent different traditions from where they are from (Jamie will create a card for students to fill out)

## Friday:

• Share "Where are you From" cards and place on the large world map

- Gallery walk
- Group share
- Dress up as your favorite character from a book
