Voice-Over: No matter the enemy

[Footage of Battlestar Galactica that was stolen for Space Mutiny]

Voice-Over: No matter the voyage

[Vague glimpses of the monster from Cloverfield]

Voice-Over: No matter what

[Shot of Channing Tatum from 21 Jump Street outside a school building]

Voice-Over: Starring Channing Tatum as Tom Dyron

Teacher: When did you go through puberty? At seven or something?

[Shot of Shia LeBeouf flailing from any movie he's in]

Voice-Over: With Shia LeBeouf as Shinji

Shia: What what wait what no no no no no no!

[Shot of Alan Baugh on the beach from Birdemic]

Voice-Over: And Alan Baugh as John Barren

Alan [Long pause]: Great!

[Crude-looking title screen announcing 'Delta Invasion']

Voice-Over: Delta Invasion. Coming this indeterminate time period.

The screen switched back to the paused fic. "So what do you think, guys?" Rebecca asked.

"I'd watch that." Rick commented. "In fact, I'd rather watch that then this."

"I think you captured the essence of Delta Invasion." Tsuneo agreed. "In so far as it's a disjointed mess."

> "No I ain't, this is bad!! I mean really bad!"

Rick [Tom]: Game over man, game over! They're coming out of the god-damn walls!

> "Come on, it's my wedding, don't give me that shit!"

Tsuneo: Yeah, Tom. Consider how someone else might feel for once in your miserable life.

- > "O.K. just for you, Shinji!"
- > "Thanks. Tom!"

Rebecca: Cue the pair of them looking wistfully into each-other's eyes.

> "But I still think I look like crap in this outfit!!!"

Rick: Not everybody can pull off bright yellow spandex, after all

> concluded Tom as there was about two hours left before the real thing started.

Dan: Time enough for everyone involved to have hysterical fits, last-minute doubts, a quickie with the one of the bridesmaids and to lose the ring at least once.

> Tom went out to see John with his new girlfriend.

Tsuneo: John has a girlfriend? With how the female characters are depicted in this fic, it'd be a challenge to see who's the shallower character.

> She had blond hair, green eyes, and was wearing a usual dress.

Dan: Say, what is a usual dress?

Rick: The opposite of an unusual dress, I guess.

- > "Hey Tom!" said John.
- > "Yo. John!" answered Tom.

Rebecca: Hello protagonist! Rick: Greetings extra!

> "Meet my new girlfriend, Jeynna Karyla, she's american too, she's moving here

> with her father!"

Rebecca: Okay, so what are the chances that Tom's ex just happens to move to Japan and just happens to hitch up with the single most boring guy on the planet, who also just happens to be Tom's number two punching bag?

Dan: Getting better all the time.

Rick: Needlessly forced coincidences are a vital narrative tool!

> "Jeynna Karyla..." said Tom remembering who she was.

Rick: She's Bruce Banner's cousin, the one who turns into the She-Hulk, right?

Dan: That's Jennifer Walters.

Rick: So she's the daughter of Lord and Lady Westerling who nursed Robb Stark back to health?

Dan: That's Jeyne Westerling, but you get points for using a character not in the HBO series.

Rick: Right. So she's a folkloric German character, falsely accused of adultery and forced to live in

a cave for six years?

Dan: That's Genevieve of Brabant, and I'd ask how the hell you came up with that one.

Rick: Of course. So she's an English writer who created an incredibly popular and influential series young adult novels about a boy who discovers that he's a wizard.

Dan: That's J. K. Rowling, and it's not even like the "J" stands for Jeynna

Rebecca: Oh I remember Tom, no matter how hard I try.

- > Jevnna said.
- > "Of course I do, what the hell do you think??" said Tom.

Dan [Tom]: Who the hell do you think I am?

Rebecca: An overbearing, obnoxious, self-important control freak with an anal fixation, but that's not important right now.

> "Yeah, I could have guessed.

Tsuneo: [Jeynna] In fact I did just guess. At the start of the scene. Leading us here.

> Anyway, you still pissed?"

Rick: Not at all., You can tell that by the way he's bearing down on her.

> "Why would I be? I got a loving girl! Soryu Asuka Langley, the girl of my life!"

Rebecca: It's the touching story of one man and his love for an imaginary animated woman

> "If you say so, I found a new guy, John, and I love him!"

Dan: In a *special* kind of a way.

> "That's what you used to say with me! And Mike..."

Rebecca: Jeynna always was jealous of what Tom and Mike had.

> "He told you? God damnit!"

Tsuneo: [Jeynna] I couldn't have possibly expected your best friend to tell you anything.

- > "And about how you acted like a slut and found another guy right after, I hear
- > real nice stories about you!"

Rebecca: Oh gee, just because she dumped you and your homie, that automatically makes her a slut? Since you hitched up with Asuka long before you knew she'd left you, what does that make you then? Beyond a flaming hypocrite, that is.

Tsuneo: So he forgives Matt for killing hundreds of innocents and trying to destroy the world, but he can't forgive one girl for dumping him. Real mature there.

- > "Argh!!! Look, when you left to Japan, Mike was being really nice to me telling
- > me not to worry and all, I couldn't resist...

Tsuneo: Doubtless Mike is beyond reproach in all this.

> "That's great, Jeynna, I'm gonna write a book called "The 1001 Sluty Ways Of

> Jeynna Karyla". It would be sold a lot, I think!"

Rick: So in short, he's not upset at all.

Dan: Gods no.

> "Shut up, Tom, god damnit, I'm sorry!"

Rebecca [Jeynna]: I'm so sorry that you're an overbearing jerkarse who can't get over the fact that I left you and decided to get on with my life rather than remaining hung up on it for years afterwards.

> "Like I still care.

Dan: So why's he making such an issue of it?

Tsuneo: So he can prove what a man he is by emotionally beating down on a girl

> I'm afraid of whatever bitchy thing you might do to him,

Tsuneo: [Tom] Like being distraught when he abandons you to fly across the world.

> he's such a sweet guy, damnit,

Rick: He's special, you know.

Tsuneo: He's sweet in the way that he's never displayed a shred of emotion. Just take our word for it

> I wonder what the fuck you might do to him!"

Rebecca: She's going to pay attention to John and treat him like a human being. Oh, it's horrible!

> "Look, I love John and I won't do anything to hurt him, do you fucking understand that, Tom Dyron????"

Tsuneo: Another person said it, so um... No.

> "Yeah, I understand that you're full of shit..."

Rebecca: I'm still convinced this girl is a real person the authour knows who dumped him for being such a jerk. There's far too much hate here for a fictional construct.

Dan: What, and this part of the fic is just him taking out his anger on her?

Rebecca: In a kind of passive-aggressive, 'I'm angry but don't have the balls to actually confront them over it' way.

> Jessica slapped Tom.

Rick: Who's this Jessica person and why is she slapping Tom?

Rebecca: I don't know, but I want to applaud her.

> "You know, I don't really give a crap, so calm down!

Tsuneo: Despite all evidence to the contrary.

Rick: So this whole piece is him saying "I'm still hung up about it two and a half years later."

> I don't know what's wrong with you, Jeynna.

Dan: Says the guy shouting at her.

- > What happened to the cool girl I once knew?"
- > "She changed, she became more mature and she..."

Rebecca: -went to university, got a degree and now has a successful and rewarding career as a financial systems manager.

> said Jeynna as Tom interrupted her with an eye contact.

Rick: Laser beam eyes! Pew pew!

> "You became dirty whore, a ho, nothing less to say.

Rebecca: That's right, her entire worth in life is based on a single teenage relationship.

> You still look as good, but you have a bad attitude."

Rick: And a matching black GMC panel van.

> "Tom, can you just stop this???"

All: Please?

- > said Jeynna as she stood and looked at Tom straight in the eyes with a begging look.
- > "Jeynna, I forgive you for what you've done to me, but what you did to Mike... I just can't.

Rick: How dare you dump him for some unspecified reason.

> Give me some time..."

Tsuneo: Like say, the last two years?

Rick: Being fair, those were timeskips, and apparently nothing actually happened during them.

> "God, you changed too, Tom!"

Dan: And about time too. That stupid 'Rollerbladers Suck' shirt was getting pretty rank.

> "Yeah, I became famous as a singer

Dan: I note that we haven't heard from Dragons of Doom in the last two years. I'm guessing the re-launch of the band didn't take off that well.

Rebecca: They now play at shopping mall openings, bowling clubs... anywhere that will pay them, really.

> and I'm the only champion of the "No Holds Barred Tournament"

Rick: The only champion? So did they never hold it again?

Tsuneo: There was an investigation after it was discovered that they'd let a known wanted serial killer into the tournament. Found out that members of the organizing committee had been taking huge payoffs for

years to let people enter without background checks. As a result, it was shut down.

> so, hell yeah I changed!"

Rebecca: You've become a bigger dickhead then you were before.

> "Not in that way, you're more sincere, and you don't care about what you say to > girls, now, that's what I meant."

Tsuneo: He's verbally abusing her and it's a good thing.

> "Get used to the new Tom, the one that got what he wanted in life

Rebecca: [Tom] I've got all the adulation from fictional characters I could ever want.

> and that doesn't wanna change anymore..."

Dan: And how's that any different to how he was before.

> "Hmm... you're right, but you're not the same to me."

Rebecca: Didn't we just say that?

- > "Oh, I'm not?? Well guess what? I don't give a rat's ass!"
- > "I know, you changed..."

Dan: [Shouting] I change to be the same!

> The conversation ended on this last sentence.

Dan: Hey Rebecca?

Rebecca: Yeah, what's up?

Dan: I know I can be a bit of a tool sometimes, but I'm pretty sure I'm not that much of a jerk.

Rebecca: Dan... And I can't believe I'm saying this, but... Tom makes you look good.

Dan [Asuka]: Okay, all the times I acted like that to the last Rei. Rebecca [Rei]: That's different.

- > "I did, and I know it, so I'd like to apologize for all of those, O.K.?"
- > "Accorded. I had forgotten about those anyway, Asuka!"

Rick: It's a clone thing; you just learn to get used to it. That and the navel in the back of your neck.

> "Good, now, congratulations about you and Shinji, I'm happy for the both of you!"

Rebecca [Asuka]: And about how you can move out of the apartment and we never see you again.

> "Thank you, Asuka, thank you very much!"

Tsuneo: Spoken with all the sincerity of a used car salesman

> Tom was drinking another beer as he lighted a cigarette.

Dan: Tom's wedding photos look more or less the same as his mugshots.

> When he was done.

Tsuneo: He knocked back some bourbon, did some vodka shots and finished it all off with a bottle of tequila.

> he got ready because the wedding was now about to start.

Rick: They'd run out of excuses and finally found Asuka. She was hiding in the ladies, sobbing uncontrollably as she devoured a box of chocolates.

> Tom and Shinji stood on one altar, and Asuka and Rei stood on the other.

Dan: Um, you guys? Together? In the middle?

> The four of them slowly walked down the aisle. The ceremony was going fine

Dan [Gendo]: I always cry at weddings.

Rick [Fuyutski]: Yes.

> except that Tom felt humiliated to be shown to everyone in a suit.

Rebecca: Jeynna was videoing it all on her phone. She was going to upload all her footage of Tom adjusting himself and scratching his bum to Youtube afterwards

> When the ceremony was over

Dan: I forget, whose wedding are we at anyway?

Rick: Does it matter? They're all the same.

> and that Rei and Shinji were done kissing,

Rick: Geez, don't you guys ever breathe?

Tsuneo: This is wrong on so many levels.

Rebecca: And yet, Gendo finds the sight of his son making out with a clone of his wife strangely

fascinating [Tsuneo hits her with a cushion]

> Tom ran to change yelling "I HATE THOSE GODDAMN SUITS!!!!"

Rebecca: And yet he has no problems with wearing form-fitting rubber. Make of this what you will.

> Rei soon told everyone that she was pregnant...

Dan: It must have been one hell of a reception. Shinii's family on one side. Rei's family in test tubes... Rick [Gendo]: I'd like to just remind the young bride and groom that I do run an omnipotent evil conspiracy and that I can and will make people 'disappear' as I see fit.

> About nine months later, October 26th, 2020...

Dan: And in the meantime...

Rick: Rei took the Bar in record time, Toji and Kensuke split off to form their own band "Giant Robot Car," Pen-Pen laid a clutch of eggs and Ritsuko began construction on her brainchild, the Star Eva II

> Tom rushed with Asuka to the hospital where Rei had probably just gave birth to her child.

Rebecca: Probably? This is one of those things that you're certain about, one way or the other. Rick: Retcons permitting.

> Tom suddenly busted the hell in with Asuka

Rick: Ironically, right under the "No busting the hell in" sign.

> to see Shinji stressed out as hell as he held the baby up.

Dan: On top of the rock while all the animals bowed and Elton John played in the background.

> John soon rushed in too.

Tsuneo: He'd mistaken the maternity ward for a nearby bar. Again.

> "Boy or girl, ol' pal??" said Tom.

Rick: [Shinji] I don't know, I slept through biology.

> "It's a boy!" said Shinji, "A new Ayanami!"

Tsuneo: As opposed to Gendo's method of making new Ayanamis, I suppose.

Rebecca: Right now, Rei would prefer that method.

- > "What's his name??" asked Tom.
- > "Lyn, Ayanami Lyn..." said Rei.
- > "Lyn? What a beautiful name!!!"

Rebecca: With a name like that, the kid's going to get tormented for life.

Rick: His only friend? The boy named Susan.

> said Asuka as she congratulated both Shinji and Rei.

Tsuneo: While also suggesting to Tom just how she'd kill him if he put her through the same thing.

> Tom was clapping repeating "Dat's my boy, Shinji, way to go!!!!"

Dan [Tom]: I gotta get me one of them things. How'd you guys make it?

> The same year, at Nerv HQ,

Rebecca: We're losing track of the timeline here, folks.

Dan: Wanna go for another timeskip round? Rick: Nah, wait until we have a specific break.

> Gendo was standing alone in front of Eva-01...

Rick [Gendo]: We never talk any more, dear.

> "I am sorry for what happened to you, Yui.

Rebecca: Still, science.

> You know I always truly loved you

Dan [Gendo]: All those other women meant nothing to me. Especially not the cheap, ugly hookers.

Tsuneo: Surprisingly, that's the case. Except the hookers.

Dan: It is? Awesome.

> and my work since 2004 was to see you again...

Rebecca: Even if Yui's lawyers said otherwise.

> I completed the Instrumentality

Rick: I assembled flat-packed furniture. Rebecca: I re-heated frozen waffles. Dan: I organized my sock drawer. Tsuneo: And nothing bought you back.

> and Shinji was completed,

Rick: Well, when he said completed he meant 'there were a few bits left over'. He had more luck with the flat-pack furniture.

> but I will never do it again

Dan: There are only so many times you can wipe out humanity.

> with the other Children.

Tsuneo [Gendo]: At least, nobody I know or care about.

> Since the attack made by Matt Yazama, I figured out that Evas were too dangerous

Rick: It took him two years to reach this conclusion?
Rebecca: He had other things on his mind. Mainly shagging Ritsuko silly.

- > and were to be kept from moving crucified like Lilith on her cross in Terminal
- > Dogma. All Evas will take her place. I know that the Eva will feel pain, but you
- > won't. I know that inside you are kept with Lilith's soul which made some of
- > Eva-01's berserk states uncontrollable, and I am sorry..."

Tsuneo: I'd say that this makes no sense whatsoever and runs contrary to, well, everything in the series, but after chapter eleven it's rather minor. That and I don't want to find out if the Monk's up here.

> Gendo looked straight through the Eva's eyes wondering

Dan: What happened to the colour.

> if Yui would give him a response.

Rick: Answer unclear, ask again later.

Rebecca [Gendo]: I mean, having sex with a giant robot? It's uncomfortable and awkward [Tsuneo hits her with a cushion] You can't say he hasn't tried it.

Tsuneo: Well, no...

> now that our son has married Ayanami Rei, he can be happy.

Dan: Pressing out freakish malformed babies.

> I hope that he does not hate me forever though...

Rick: Just wait till Shinji's autobiography comes out, Gendo. Then you're in trouble.

> Justice was beaten, but it was really close,

Rebecca: The betting was going insane in the last moments. Fortunes were won and lost that day.

> but all Angels are defeated now..."

Rick: Or are they!

Dan: No, I'm pretty sure they are. Rick: Well okay then. Carry on.

> finished Gendo.

Rick: [Gendo] You're getting all this right? I mean, I'd feel pretty stupid just standing here talking to the cage otherwise...

> But suddenly, he heard step sounds coming from behind him.

Rebecca: Its moments like these that Gendo's glad he always carries a concealed gun.

> When he turned around, he saw Shinji, Ayanami Shinji now looking at him.

Rebecca: Very glad indeed.

> "Father, we need to have a talk, a talk that has to settle it all..."

Rebecca: [Shinji] You know, you're very mean.

Rick: [Gendo] I am?

Rebecca: [Shinji] Yes, you are.

Rick: [Gendo] I am?

Rebecca: [Shinji] Yes, you are.

Rick: [Gendo] I am?

Rebecca: [Shinji] Yes, you are. Rick: [Gendo] Well, I am what I am.

> "I know, Shinji. I know that you deeply hate me for everything I've done to you,

Dan: Including things imagined or that you made up to fill space on your Livejournal.

> but you have to underst..." tried to say Gendo as Shinji interrupted him.

Rick: To apologise for interrupting him.

> There was Rei, your wife that I was taking care of too...

Dan [Gendo]: It was the happiest day of my life.

> I didn't know what I was doing,

Rick: He honestly thought that Shinji had gotten back in the car before he drove off. Wasn't for hours later that he noticed.

Rick: [Gendo] So... Rebecca: [Shinji] So...

Rick: [Gendo] You want to go play ball, son?

Rebecca: Insert touching montage of father-son bonding here.

> then looked at Eva-01, and then straightly in each other's eyes.

Dan [Gendo]: So what say we go merchandise the living crap out of your giant root mum?

> Gendo had a sorry look while Shinji didn't know what to think or say.

Rick: Dull surprise!

- > hug of a father's love for a son.

- > crucifying all Evas in Terminal Dogma as the 3rd Children approved.

Rick: His options were otherwise limited to 'smile and nod' and 'back away slowly'.

Dan: Hey Voice? Can we run my skit now?

Voice: Sure thing!

Rebecca: Chapter three.

Dan [Tom]: I'm in love with Asuka. Rick [Shinji]: I'm in love with Rei.

Dan [Tom]: Hells yeah! Rick [Shinji]: Damn straight! Rebecca: Chapter four.

Dan [Tom]: I want revenge on the man who killed my father and my uncle, Tom's uncle!

Rick [Jeff]: I want no witnesses! [They fight with foam bats]

Rebecca: Chapter five.

Dan [Tom]: The Seventh children is coming. I should form a band. Rick [Shinji]: I have previously undiscovered musical talents!

Rebecca: Chapter six.
Tsuneo [John]: I'm special.
Dan [Tom]: He's special.
Rick [Shinji]: He's special.
Rebecca: Chapter seven.

Tsuneo [Invador]: Now that we've captured you, we'll tell you all our plans and then go to sleep.

Dan [Tom]: Kay.

Tsuneo [Invador]: How did he escape?

Rebecca: Chapter eight.

Dan [Tom]: I found a plot device. Now we fight more Invadors.

Rebecca: Chapter nine.

Dan [Tom]: I'm going into space to blow up a planet! [kicks a beachball away]

Rick [Charles]: I'm Charles, and I'm Charles.

Rebecca: Chapter ten.

Rick [Charles]: Eat hot lead everything in the general vicinity!

Rebecca: Chapter eleven.

Dan [Tom]: I know everything.

Rick [Shinji]: The half alien clone of my mum is only half my mum. That makes it okay.

Rebecca: Chapter twelve.

Dan and Rick: AND THEN THEY FIGHT! [The fight with foam bats]

Tsuneo [John]: I'm in a coma. Rebecca: Chapter thirteen.

Rick [Shinji]: Weddings for everybody! Dan [Exhausted]: Four hundred babies...

Tsuneo: The end.

"Well." Rebecca admitted. "That was... a lot better than the actual fic."

Tsuneo nodded. "And a frighteningly accurate encapsulation of it as well."

"Once again, I'd rather be watching that then this." Rick concluded. "How's about it, Voice?"

"Sorry, but you still have the rest of the chapter to go." The Voice admitted. A round of disappointed 'awwws' came from the four of them as the world switched back to script format.

> About three days later...

Dan: More or less. Closer to two, actually.

> Nerv HQ...

Rick: Formerly the Really Big Room, now the Really Empty Room That We're Not Sure What We're Doing With Anymore.

> "You're gonna what???" said Tom.

Tsuneo: That's pretty much my reaction too.

> "You heard us, crucify all Evas in Terminal Dogma, they represent too much of a

> danger!" said Dr. Akagi.

Rebecca: They've gone well beyond even the 'put them in rusty barrels in a lead-lined bunker for ten thousand years' stage.

Rick: Just banish them to the Negative Zone then. That'll work.

> "But, I like my god damn Eva!!!!" said Tom,

Dan: [Tom] It's got the boss decals and those sweet grenades. I put spinning rims on it and everything!

> "God damnit, this isn't cool!

Tsuneo: All the other kids will laugh at him because he doesn't have a giant robot like they do.

Rick: Even Shin Asuka?

Dan: Yeah, but nobody cares about him

> But it is true that Evas are very dangerous..."

Rebecca: I heard that reports of Evangelion attacks have been greatly exaggerated by media hype and sensationalism. Most Evangelions are shy and retiring and afraid to approach humans in the wild.

> "O.K. now we're going to explain you what we're going to do...

Tsuneo: And please try not to laugh.

> First we all of you to go to Terminal Dogma with all your Evas.."

Dan: Form an orderly queue in front of the symbolic structure.

> explained Ritsuko. "You're going to grab the Lance of Longinus,

Tsuneo: And remind everyone it's in this fic.

> and fix it right in the middle of the huge pentagram that we made in Terminal Dogma.

Rebecca: The inspiration for this ritual? Every metal album cover ever.

Rick: Right. But when the demonic hellbeasts from the Negative X dimension erupt through it, don't say that I didn't warn you.

> Since we repaired Eva-04 so that we could accomplish the plan.

Tsuneo: I'd point out that EVA-04 was "completely blown up", but the same happened to EVA-14 and it was fine later.

Rick: They used the power of Fixes.

> Each Eva is going to be on one edge of the pentagram.

Rebecca: I suspect that he meant 'point', unless they're lying down or something.

Dan: I think this is the point that you just surrender to the inevitable and accept and embrace the stupid. Rebecca: I'm afraid so.

> Eva-01 at the peak, Eva-03 right at its right, Eva-00 at its left, Eva-02 down left and Eva-04 in front of it.

Rick: Intense Geometrical Action!

> At its edge, a cross with the color of the Eva lies.

Dan: Is EVA-04's cross white or silver? We need to know this!

> Each Eva will be crucified on it and maintained in position by the Lance of Longinus.

Tsuneo: In all five Evangelions at once. Or something.

- > When all Evas will have put the Lance in place and taken their
- > places, the entry plug will be ejected and taken out while we use all of our
- > carrying machines to crucify each Eva with nails made of the same material as an
- > Eva's armor so that they can contain the AT Field of the Lance of Longinus and
- > paralyse the Evas.

Tsuneo: I'll just pretend that made some sense to someone and then smile and nod.

- > Each edge of the pentagram represents one of the barons of
- > darkness(Evas): the peak, The Baron of Hell(Eva-01),
- > down right, The Baron of Destruction(Eva-03),
- > to the left, The Baron of Hatred(Eva-00), down left, the Baron of Terror(Eva-02)
- > and to the right, the Baron of Sins (Eva-04).

Dan: Theology cribbed from the first edition Monster Manual.

Rick: It's an entirely eighties rock version of hell.

> But before the main room of Terminal Dogma where all Evas will be crucified,

Rebecca: They put in a Starbucks. It folded in minutes.

> there is a small room with a red floor where a gold atlar lies.

Tsuneo: That's where they'll be holding the reception. Catering staff enter through the back.

> There will be put the Blade of Souls, just like Excalibur in its rock.

Rebecca: Symbolism! Pointless and unconnected to anything above! But still, Symbolism!

> Tom will take care of that.

Dan: I wouldn't let Tom handle safety scissors. I certainly wouldn't let him loose with a powerful artifact weapon.

Tsuneo: I guess he still has to stab something in this last chapter.

- > Children, let's go!!!" finished Ritsuko.
- > "Hai!" answered all Children.

Dan: Here's a thought. Why not just blow them up? Rebecca: I'm sure the fic has a perfectly good reason.

Dan: Well does the fic feel like sharing?

> All of the Children got in their Evas as they were brought down to Terminal Dogma.

Rebecca: Three Evangelions were deployed to Terminal Dogma in eight minutes. Rick: Man, the Random Delta Invasion Episode Generator wasn't ready for this. Tsuneo: None of us were ready for this.

> Tom grabbed the Blade of Souls and watched the other Evas get in the main > room. Eva-03 walked up to the gold atlar and swang the Blade over his head

Rick: The good old swang. Glad to see it back here one last time.

> and violently slammed it into the atlar

Rick: Probably all the action we'll get in this chapter.

> making the Blade of Souls piercing through in a perfect right angle.

Tsuneo: Geometry! What does it have to do with the rest of this crap? Not a clue.

> Tom watched as the sword glew

Rick: Glew, joining his good buddy swang for one last hurrah.

> with red light and then stopped.

Dan: That means your toast's done.

> Tom walked in the main room with the others and saw a huge pentagram on

> the floor made with blackrock.

Rick: Blackrock? So it's a-

Dan: No it's not. Nor is it Florence Nightingale, Roy the Nexus Six Replicant, Steve Buscemi or the

Anti-Life Equation.

Rick: Huh. There you go.

> At each edge, he saw a huge cross with the size of an Eva and its color.

Rick: The colour of dirt?

> "Well, I guess this is our last Eva mission, I liked those machines but well, see ya Eva-03..." said Tom.

Dan: [Shinji] He's talking to the robot again, mum...

> "Yeah, the last time we're in an Eva now..." said Shinji

Rebecca: It's your last chance to have your mind and soul stretched, tortured and mutilated beyond all recognition, Shinji. Treasure it.

> as they went to grab the Lance of Longinus on the far right.

Tsuneo: I have no idea what the author thinks the Lance of Longinus is in an Evangelion context, but this is certainly not it.

> They brought it in the middle of the pentagram and slammed it by its edge(not the blade)

Rick: He's completely missing the point.

Dan: But he's making a stab at it.

- > in the middle of the
- > pentagram. The AT Field of the Lance made it bounce up and let it float straight
- > on top of the pentagram.

Rebecca: At this point, we've moved well past any semblance of logic and right into "yeah, whatever" territory

Dan: Sounds like where I live.

> "Perfect..." said Gendo.

Dan: Rick, you're the expert. Was that an "At long last" perfect, or more of an "All part of the plan" one?

Rick: I'd say it's most likely the classic "The fools have served me well" kind.

Dan: Sweet.

> All Evas walked back and got in the exact position the Evas were supposed to

> take on each cross.

Rick: Then Rei and Asuka wanted to change places and got into a fight over it.

> Their entry plugs were ejected and taken out as carrying flying machines

Rebecca: "Carrying flying machines". Wow, we are being vauge, aren't we?

- > came near each Eva piercing each Eva's hand, and pierced both
- > legs together just like Jesus Christ on his cross,

Dan: You know, this whole thing reminds me of something, but I can't remember what.

Tsuneo: Come on, Dan. It's obvious what this is meant to be.

Dan: Oh yeah. Life of Brian.

> and one nail was pierced right into each Eva's Core.

Rick: Ow! Stings a bit.

> They all got in a safe position as the Lance glew to a bright light

Rick: First swang and now another glew? They pulled out all the stops for this finale.

- > and all the energy flew into the nails making each Eva glow and
- > as the souls of each Eva flew into the Lance.

Rebecca: That thing really sucks the life out of a get-together.

> The whole room was now covered by the AT light as everything went back to normal

Tsuneo: Nothing is normal about this.

> except that every Eva and the Lance were now glowing of a bright white light.

Rick: And at the middle of it? Sinestro.

- > On the gold circle around the
- > pentagram, a circular light going up to the roof was lighting around all Evas
- > and the Lance.

Rebecca: Gendo's planning on turning Terminal Dogma into a disco. Got the lighting installed already.

> All Children starred at it a long time

Dan: Duh, pretty...

- > before going back up to Central Dogma.
- > Once up there...

Rebecca: Now the really smart thing to do would be to then fill all that in with concrete to provide a physical barrier in addition to the metaphysical one.

Tsuneo: Don't think soul-sucking artifacts are enough?

Rebecca: I prefer security measures that I can poke.

> "Well, I guess it's over for all Evas..." said Tom as he looked down then up and

> said: "But no more muthafuckin' Invadors or Angels!!!!" as everyone cheered.

Rick: W-wait... but if they crucified the Evangelions...

Tsuneo: Something wrong?

Rick: What will they do when the inevitable Invador alert occurs?

Tsuneo: Are you sure there's even going to be one. I mean-

Rick: There has to be! [Grabs Tsuneo by the shirt front] I mean, it's going to be a last-minute twist or something, like nobody saw it coming and then the Invadors drop from the sky. And then they have to use fixes to get the Evangelions back in action in a desperate race against time to stop the last charge of the Invador swarm.

Tsuneo: I just don't think it's going to happen.

Rick: No, it has to! I just can't accept that the last chapter of Delta Invasion is going to be nothing but weddings and babies and babies and weddings and four hundred babies! There has to be more to it! There has to be more to life!

Dan: Dude, it's just a crappy fanfic. No point in getting worked up over it.

Rick: Oh yeah [Lets Tsuneo go and sits down]

> just like Shinji's mother but he had the face of Rei.

Tsuneo: Guest appearance by a young Yushiro Gowa.

> "Such a cute baby..." said Asuka as the baby held one of her fingers.

Rebecca: He tried to start third impact in his crib. He's so adorable.

> "Thanks, Asuka!!" said Rei as Misato and Kaji walked in.

Rick: Kaji had already begun pilfering food from the buffet table.

> Three year old Mana was walking near her.

Rebecca: She can already say "hangover" and "rehab."

> "Whoa, the baby has grown up!"

Dan [Tom]: Babies do that, right?

Others: Yes, Tom.

> said Tom as he kneeled near Mana, "Hey, what's up?"

Rebecca [Mana]: My mum says you're a bum.

> "Hi, Mr. Dyron..." said the girl.

Rick: I'm surprised she recongised him. Most pics of Tom have his face blurred out, as well as those of the cops leading him off. They also have to blur out some other things on occasion

> "Mr. Dyron???" said Tom as Shinji and Kaji laughed. "Call me Tom!"

Tsuneo: [Mana] Goodnight, Uncle Tom.

> "Yes, Mr. Tom Dyron, sir..." said Mana. '

Dan: [Mana] Mama says don't talk to strangers and you're strange as they come.

> "Huh..." said Tom.

> "O.K. Tom!" said Mana.

Tsuneo: So here's a question. If we're on the last chapter, why is it made up of filler? Rick: Because the author only now realized that he ran out of plot when they killed Justice.

- > "That's better!!!" responded Tom as heard Rei's baby say "T... Tom...".
- > "Whoa! Can your baby talk, Rei??" asked Asuka.

Rebecca: Talk and differentiate first-order polynomials. He's a fast learner.

Tsuneo: For such supposedly close friends, you'd think they would have met each other's kids by now. Rick: Actually, they've been trying to keep the kids away from Tom but finally realised the futility.

> Tom, Shinji and Kaji in their corner.

Tsuneo: Each with their dunce caps, no doubt.

- > "God damn, that's having kids!! Holy crap!" said Tom.
- > "You know, it ain't that bad!" said Kaji.

Rebecca: Not bad for the father. All he has to do is grunt for a few minutes and that's his end of the deal out of the way.

> "If you say so!" responded Tom thinking Kaji was bullshitting him.

Rick: How much time do you reckon Kaji actually spends looking after his kid? Be honest.

> Now was the wedding time...

Dan: And time for some zany comedy antics!

Dan: You know, Queen actually performed a wedding march for the Flash Gordon soundtrack.

Rick: Seriously? What brings that to mind?

Rebecca: Who's to bet that Tom's involvement with the planning largely amounted to pretending to listen to Asuka while drinking?

> Shinji smacked him hard as Tom woke up.

Dan: [Shinji] You missed it. We're onto the divorce proceedings.

> "Wha???" mumbled Tom. "Oh, right, my wedding, whateva you say Mr. Priest, I agree!!"

Tsuneo: Tom, you just married a goat. Well done.

- > Tom waited for the preacher to be done as he kissed Asuka before the preacher
- > was done saying "You may kiss the bride." Tom yelled again "SUITS TIGHTEN THE
- > DAMN BALLS, I AM SUEING WHOEVER CREATED SUITS!!!"

Rick [Asuka]: What?! You dare ruin the great Asuka's wedding?! WA-TAK! I want a divorce!

[Pause]

Dan: Dude. I think you just nailed that sound effect!

Rick: I did? Awesome!

> About two months later, Asuka said that she was pregnant.

Dan: In the meantime...

Rebecca: No such luck.

Dan [Tom]: Dude, what's this horrible screaming pink thing anyway?

> his name is Trent, Trent Dyron!" said Tom.

Rick [Asuka]: Excuse me! What about me? Don't *I* get a say in his name? WA-TAK! Rebecca: I think it's really working for you

> The baby had piercing blue eyes like his mother but black as night hair like his father.

Tsuneo: And thus Tom's baby is better described then Matt Yazama or Charles. Nice going, fic.

> "Congratulations!!!" said Kaji and Misato.

Dan: Babies for everyone! Rick: Four hundred babies!

Rick: His hard rock lifestyle apartment.

> Shinji, Asuka, Rei and Tom were sitting on a coach,

Dan: In case you missed the last twenty pages. And the twelve chapters before that.

> John is still with Jeynna

Dan: And I heard that Jessica hooked up with Charles. Or was that Charles?

Rick: What about Sean, Shauna and Shaundi? [Tsuneo raps him on the head] Yeah, I deserved that.

> and I wonder when he's gettin' the ring around his ringfinger..."

Dan: Because dammit, everyone in the civilized world gets married to their first girlfriend.

Rebecca: Bitter, Dan? Dan: Yeah, right.

> "I wonder too, it's been years that they've been together..." said Rei.

Rebecca: She's just doing it to spite you, Tom. Rick: Nah, she just wants to be special too.

> "Anyways, it's his life!" said Tom.

Tsuneo: What, the one you tried to mess up by chasing off his girlfriend?

> "Yeah, you're right, Tom!" said Shinji,

Tsuneo: He's never had a life of his own before. It's a novel experience.

> "Remember when we were just 16, Tom?"

Rebecca: [Shinji] When you were just an incoherent, overbearing idiot?

Dan: [Shouting] I all real growed up now!

Rebecca: [Shinji] Never mind.

> "Yeah, I remember the day I met all of you guys and that you bumped into me when

> I was skating.

Rick: [Tom] When I ran over your dog?

> Nice way to meet, huh?" said Tom.

All: No.

> "Yeah... and then, I met Tom at Nerv HQ for his synchro tests..." said Rei.

Tsuneo: It's flashing back to the start of the fanfic! Help!

> "And when we all met when we were 14..." said Shinji,

Tsuneo: [Shinji] My life was a series of pyrrhic victories and soul-crushing tragedies, but I was happier because I didn't have Tom.

> "But Tom wasn't here so that we could form the Brady Bunch..." as everyone laughed.

Rick: Notice how they don't mention meeting John.

> "What a life we had..." said Tom, "But finaly we have a normal one!"

Dan: That's right, getting married to a half-clone of your mother and having kids while you're still both teenagers is normal!

> "I don't know why, but I think we should go at the cliff, like good ol' days!" said Tom.

Rebecca: No, this doesn't sound like a needlessly forced way of drawing a conclusion at all.

> "Yeah, I think that would be great...

Tsuneo: In case you had missed it the first thousand times this chapter: they can now live normal lives.

> "It's the way life is!" said Shinji.

Dan: Wasn't that an 80's ballad? Rick: I think this whole chapter was.

Dan: And mooch off.

> are the best reasons to live happy and to have nothing to worry about.

Rick [Max the Bunny]: That's touching. I may weep openly.

> Now that the Angels were gone,

Rebecca: [Faint] I'm not dead yet!

> all the Children that were now married could rest in peace... for now!

Rick: Not noticing the small black object floating towards the base of the cliff.

Dan [Ominous]: Flesh... Jeff Garyn of Earth... rise!

> End of Final Genesis(Genesis 0:26) and End of : Neon Genesis Evangelion II : D.E.L.T.A. Invasion

Dan: Or is it!

Rebecca: No, I actually think it is. Dan: Well, okay then. Never mind.

Rick: Cue closing theme by currently popular yet eminently forgettable band. Roll credits.
